ORDINANCE NUMBER 667

AN ORDINANCE, providing for the issuance of internal improvement bonds of the City of Garnett, Kansas, to pay for the paving, curbing and guttering of certain portions of certain streets and avenues in said City.

Whereas, in pursuance of proceedings duly had and taken according to law, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas, contracts have been let for the paving, curbing, and guttering of Fifth Avenue from the West Line of Main Street to the West Line of Parith Street and Oak Street from the North Time of Fifth Avenue to the South Line of Hourth Avenue and Frourth Avenue from the West Line of Main Street to the midself of maple Street in soid City

Whereas, all legal requirements have been fully complied with to authorize the issuance of bonds of said city on account of said improvements: now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

between the limits hereinbefore stated, there shall be issued a series of bonds of said City of Garnett in the aggregate amount of \$32,846.08, which shall consist of 30 bonds of \$1000.00 each, and 9 bonds of \$300.00 each and one bond of \$146.08, bearing date of September 1, 1916, numbered from one to forty, inclusive, bearing interest at the rate of four and three-fourths per cent per annum payable semi-annually on March and September 1st of each year, shall become due payable as follows:

promises to pay the bearer the sum of
DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States of America, on the first
day of September, A. D. 19, with interest thereon at the rate of
four and three-fourths per centum $(4\frac{3}{4}\%)$ per annum, payable semi-annually
on the First day of March and September of each year after the date
hereof, until the principal sum shall be paid, upon presentation and
surrender of the proper interest coupons hereto attached as they sever-
ally become due and both principal and interest are payable at the office
of the Treasurer of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas,
and the City of Garnett is hereby held and firmly bound and its faith
and credit and all the real and personal property in said city are
hereby pledged for the prompt payment of the principal and interest
of this bond at maturity.

This bond is one of a series of Forty (40), numbered from one to forty (1 to 40) inclusive, aggregating the sum of Thirty-Two Thousand, Eight Hundred Forty-Six and 08/100 (\$32,846.08) Dollars, issued by the city of Garnett for the purpose of paying for the paving, curbing and guttering of certain avenues in said City, by the Authority of, and in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Kansas, governing cities of the second class, and in compliance with the provisions of an ordinance duly and legally passed, published and approved by the Board of Commissioners of saidCity.

And it is hereby declared and certified that all acts, conditions and things required to be done and to exist precedent to and in the issuing of this bond, have been properly done and performed and do exist in regular and due form as required by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Kansas, and that total indebtedness of said city, including this series of bonds, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitations.
