Gospel **Luke 1:26-38** [26](#) In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth,[27](#) to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin's name was Mary.[28](#) And he came to her and said, “Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you!”[29](#) But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of greeting this might be.[30](#) And the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.[31](#) And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus.[32](#) He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. 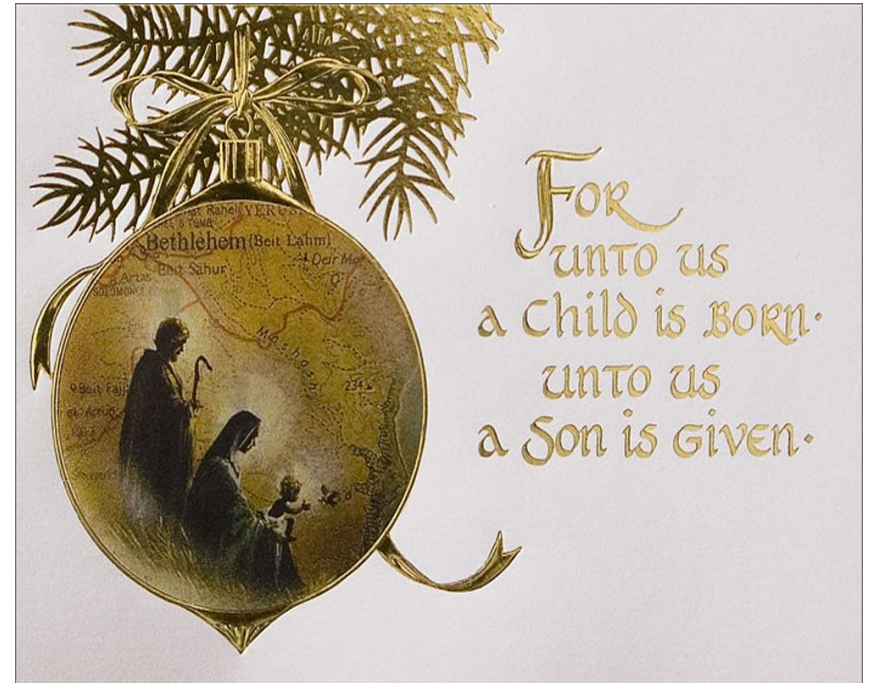
