Garbage

Your garbage service should only be delayed twice during 2021:

Memorial Day — pick up will be Wednesday, June 2nd

Labor Day — pick up will be Wednesday, September 8th

Sewer/WWTF

EVERYTHING that goes into the toilet, or down your drain, comes out at the Waste Water Treatment Facility. Many of these items cause damage to the treatment facility and prevent the process from working the way it should. In addition to major expenses associated with fixing the system, foreign substances cause misreads on our required testing, which can lead to violations and fines.

"Disposable" wipes do not break down. Neither do Q-tips, diapers, pills, paper towels, feminine products, grease, fats and oils.

Nothing should go down the drains except human waste and toilet paper.

Water

As the ground thaws in the spring, it is expected to see quite a bit of natural run-off, but if you see something that looks like it could be more than just ground water, please contact Town Hall so Public Works can check it out.
