Registration for 2026 - 2027

Pre-registration for current RCS students: Monday, December 1st through Friday, December 5th. Registration begins at 8:00 am on December 1st in - person as the registration forms are able to be downloaded a few days before. This is in order to make it fair for all interested parents who wanted to try to secure a spot for their child for next year. We will have classes based on enrollment interest and cannot guarantee that all will be able to place their child in their first choice of class. Registration is on a first come first serve basis and is in -person only, **NOT ONLINE**. After December 1st, if you have not registered your child yet for next year but wish to do so, please send in your registration form along with your deposit to secure your child's placement. After this we will open registration to the public as of December 8th.

*It is strongly advised that you send in your registration form with your deposit as soon as possible. On December 8th, 2025, registration is open to the public. If you have not signed up prior to this date, there is no guarantee that you will receive your first choice, especially important that our current 3's sign up this first week as there is ONLY room (after the current 3's sign up) now for ONE new four for the fall as a result of so many THREES THIS YEAR and we have received inquiries for new families who are interested for 4's next year .
