Exterior Siding, Window, and Trim Repair & Interior Finish Work

Interlaken Public Library – Fire Damage Restoration Village of Interlaken, New York

1. Introduction

The Village of Interlaken is seeking qualified contractors to provide labor, materials, and equipment necessary to repair exterior siding, windows, trim, and related components at the Interlaken Public Library following fire-related damage. Work also includes interior finish and painting around newly installed windows, along with proper disposal of all removed materials.

2. Project Location

3. Scope of Work

The selected contractor shall perform all tasks necessary to restore the building exterior and affected interior finishes, including but not limited to:

A. Exterior Work

- 1. Remove and dispose of damaged siding, exterior trim, damage down spout and or gutter, and any charred or compromised building materials in the affected fire-damage area(s).
- 2. Remove and dispose of damaged windows and prepare openings for new units.
- 3. Supply and install new windows matching existing sizes and profiles.
- 4. Install new siding and exterior trim to match the existing building.
- 5. Install new downspout and gutter to match existing building.
- 6. Ensure all exterior work is weatherproofed, including flashing, caulking, insulation, and sealing.
- 7. Dispose of all removed materials per regulations.

B. Interior Work

- 1. Reuse or replace (if not salvageable), interior window trim around the newly installed windows.
- 2. Prepare surfaces for painting, including sanding, priming, patching, and cleaning.
- 3. Paint all interior trim to match existing colors and finishes or as directed.
- 4. Ensure debris is removed and the work area is cleaned.

C. Contractor Responsibilities

- Provide all required permits.
- Maintain a clean, safe worksite.
- Coordinate with Library and Village staff to minimize disruption.
- Provide proof of insurance including liability and workers compensation, listing the Village of Interlaken and Interlaken Public Library as additionally insured.

4. Site Visit

A site visit can be scheduled upon request or during regular library hours. Contractors are strongly encouraged to inspect the building before submitting a proposal.

5. Proposal Requirements

Interested contractors must submit a written proposal including:

- 1. Company information and point of contact.
- 2. Detailed cost estimate with itemized materials and labor. (a sample sheet is provided)
- 3. Proposed project timeline.
- 4. Description of similar projects completed in the past 5 years.
- 5. Proof of insurance.
- 6. Any exclusions or assumptions in the proposal.

6. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on:

25% - Experience and qualifications 30% - Cost and bid completeness

10% - Ability to meet schedule 15% - Quality of references and previous work

20% - Compliance with RFP requirements

7. Submission Instructions

Proposals must be received no later than:

January 14th, 2026, at 4:00pm

A. Labor and Compliance

- **Invoicing:** Final invoicing must be submitted on a lien-waived basis.
