

- Table assignments will be first come, first served
- Set up begins at 2:45 PM; must be completed by 3:45 PM
- Open to the public 4PM to 7PM
- Winners will be announced at 6:45 PM

ATTENTION!

All attendees over 5 years of age, including all non-profit volunteers, must purchase an individual door ticket to enter. NO EXCEPTIONS.
[It's a FUNdraiser!]

What to Bring:

- 1.5 Gallons of salsa made with fresh ingredients (to be served by your group volunteers during the event—**salsa must be prepared in a commercial kitchen**)
- If you are in need of a commercial kitchen, several local churches will be available for dates and times the week of the event; these are to be determined.
- Table decorations and organization display
- Have receipts for all ingredients available for the health inspector

What is Provided:

- 3' - 6' of table space depending on # of participants
- Small serving spoons, chips, ice bowls (to set salsa bowls in), and salsa cups
- Refreshments available for purchase from the St. James

Contests – Dress up and have some fun!

Best Salsa - People's Choice (must be present to vote)

Judged Categories - Best Red Salsa, Best Green Salsa, Best Fruit Salsa, Best Bean Salsa, Best Costume, Best Salsa Name

- You are responsible to take out anything that you bring in. Make sure you have all of your materials with you when you leave (buckets, utensils etc.)

Why a Salsa Contest AND a Raffle?

Since 2013 we've all had a blast as part of what we humbly think is one of the best fund-raiser, friend-raisers of the year. COVID forced us to cancel our 2021 in-person event, so we tried a charitable raffle that year instead. And to our great surprise, we raised more money in raffle ticket sales than we ever had before. So, if the in-person event is great, and the raffle ticket sales were off the chart, why not do both?!?

How can my organization participate?

If your non-profit would like to join us in the fundraising, please first complete the Salsalicious Registration Form 2026 and submit it to Barb Seaberg either by email to bjseaberg@yahoo.com or by mail to Barb at 1303 East Avenue in Red Wing.

On that registration form, you'll need the name, number, and email address of your principal contact, as well as the number of raffle tickets you'd like. [As an aside, and you likely already guessed this, but your organization must participate in the Salsalicious event on April 7th, 2026 in order to participate in the raffle fundraiser.]

Tickets

- (1) Raffle tickets should be available the week of February 2nd, 2026.
- (2) They will be distributed to you immediately, but please note #3 below.
- (3) Charitable gambling rules in Minnesota are robust and require us to act accordingly. Every printed ticket must be accounted for, and unsold tickets must be returned. Because of this, the committee has decided that each non-profit must first pay \$5 per ticket for each one they receive. Not to worry, however, because 100% of that money will be returned if 100% of your tickets are either sold or the un-sold are returned.
- (4) Speaking of rules, no one under 18 years of age may purchase a ticket. Tickets must each be printed with a unique number, and purchased with cash or check. NO CREDIT CARD PURCHASES ARE ALLOWED! [There is an option for debit cards, but it includes extra steps so please speak with Ethan Seaberg before going that route.]
- (5) Tickets must be sold for the face value of \$20 each. Need not be present to win.
- (6) ALL TICKETS, BOTH THE STUBS FROM THE SOLD ONES AND WHOLE UNSOLD TICKETS, MUST BE DELIVERED TO BARB SEABERG AT 1303 EAST AVENUE IN RED WING NO LATER THAN NOON ON TUESDAY, MARCH 24TH, 2026!

Where does the ticket money from our sales get deposited?

The Red Wing Masonic Lodge. As the sponsor, the Lodge must ensure that each ticket is sold for \$20 by doing a little math. [Ex. Stubs from 100 sold tickets should be accompanied by \$2,000 in cash, or in checks made out to Red Wing Masonic Lodge.]

How much of the \$20 ticket price does my non-profit receive?

All of it. Because of our generous sponsors who have covered our expenses, all money raised by your organization will be returned to you, in addition to a split of the net sponsorship money and your \$5 ticket deposits.

What are the prizes?

Grand Prize: \$3,000 travel credit through Shelley Orr’s Travel Leaders in Red Wing
