Subject: Floyd County Sheriff's Office Makes Drug Bust after Receiving a Complaint of a Mobile Meth-Lab.

On Saturday, October 24th, Sheriff John Hunt and deputies responded to a complaint of a green 2001 Chevrolet Cavalier being driven in the Auxier community of Floyd County with what the caller described a meth lab inside of the vehicle. Sheriff Hunt located the vehicle on KY 321 near the entrance to Auxier. During a search of the vehicle, Deputies did in fact find an in-active lab in the trunk which contained all the ingredients or pre-cursors used in the manufacturing of meth, including cooking utensils, propane gas, lithium batteries, packages of Sudafed, cold packs and liquid drain opener. Deputies also discovered a white crystal like substance believed to be crystal meth along with marijuana, prescription pills and drug paraphernalia.
