Aloha Kakou,

Last month I talked about the impending clergy shortage in the ELCA, asking what is a pastor, what is the priesthood of all believers, and who can afford a pastor.

This week I saw part of the sanctuary ceiling on the floor, where it had come crashing down. Lots of people said something like, "Thank God no one was hurt!" I thought about this response because in terms of timing, the sanctuary is used about five percent of the week at the most. So, the odds of someone getting hurt was slim to none.

That being said, we do have to ask, "What next?" I know nothing about stucco ceilings, but I am wondering how secure the rest of the ceiling is. Could it come crashing down during the five percent of the time people are in the sanctuary?

We were going to start a capital campaign to finish the refurbishment of the offices and establish a gathering place for us to use, even when preschool is in session. Now, we need to look at the scope of the risk in the sanctuary, too, and its costs. The good news is that we have done this twice before during my thirteen years with you. We have done some major capital improvements over the years, paid off the debt, and even continued to pay the mortgage down.

Let us continue to ask what is Church? What is a pastor, who is a priest, and how do we be Church for each other and the world around us. Even as we pray for the Spirit's guidance, I suspect we will be having those conversations quite a bit through the next few weeks and months.

Give Aloha Begins September 1st

Once again CLC is registered to participate in the annual Give Aloha program, sponsored by Foodland/Western Union.

How It Works

From **September 1-30**, customers are invited to make donations of up to \$249 to participating Hawaii non-profit organizations at checkout. Donations are accepted at any Foodland, Sack N Save or Foodland Farms checkout. Foodland and the Western Union Foundation will match a portion of each donation. Individuals must use their own Maika'i number to make a donation. Donations made without a Maika'i number will not be matched.

How to Donate

At checkout, present your Maika'i card (or provide your number) and inform the cashier that you would like to make a donation to **Christ Lutheran Church**, code number 77769. If you do not have a Maika'i card/number, you may request to establish one. Your donation will be added to your grocery purchase total. You may donate up to \$249 per organization; any portion exceeding \$249 will not be matched. The amount you donate and the name of our organization will appear on your receipt. Donations must be payable to Foodland or Sack N Save.

Acknowledgement of Your Donation

Donor names will not be released to our organization. Therefore, if you would like to us to know of your gift, (and include it on your quarterly statement for tax purposes), please contact us directly so that we may properly acknowledge your gift & ask the cashier for a duplicate receipt to submit to us. These gifts are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law. Keep your receipt for tax purposes.

Matching Gift

CLC will receive 100% of all customer donations given to us, plus each donation made with a Maika'I membership will be partially matched by a gift from Foodland and the Western Union Foundation. Matching gifts will be determined at the end of the program.
