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### Note to All Interested Food Vendors:

- Food should be of good quality and freshly prepared. Each booth should have a specialty food item. Your specialty food product that you're selling should not be the same as other food booths. However, a side item such as fries is okay.
- Please include a menu of items that you wish to sell and attach to your application.
- Any pre-prepared items must be completed in a certified commercial kitchen. We will assist you with available location(s) and scheduling for your group, if necessary.
- Electric will be provided to your booth. Any special requirements other than our festival standard electric service must be made in advance.
- Your booth will be required to undergo an inspection by the Morgan County Health Department. You must pass inspection before you can start selling any food items. The inspection fee is included in the price of the booth.
- Food booth fee is \$375 for food booths set up in downtown near main tent and includes inspection fee, electric, booth moving to and from the festival location and set-up (if needed), and any oil mats that may be needed on the outside of your booth. Commercial food vendors with a license will pay a reduced fee if no inspection is needed.
- Food vendors that set up in Old Mill Park will have a reduced fee to be determined by the committee and will be contingent on any electrical or other special requirements.
- Any grease/oil shall be removed from the site by the food vendor at the conclusion of the festival. Grease/oil removal is the responsibility of the food vendor and absolutely no grease shall be poured down storm drains or anywhere on site.
- Soft drinks may be sold at a fee agreed upon by majority of food vendors and the food vendor committee chairman.
- This is just an application. Your application will be reviewed by the Festival Committee. If approved, you will be promptly notified and provided with additional details.
- Deadline for applications is **June 1, 2026**.
