A message from their daughter Bethan

Keith and Menna moved to Upminster in 1968 with their three children Jane, Paul and John, Bethan arrived the following year.

They attended the church, with the children active in the Sunday school, Brownies and Cubs. Keith stepped up to help in the cubs as Baloo and in time took on the Scouts and became the Scout leader or Skip! Many camps and hikes were undertaken and many new friends made. During his tenure the new Beaver colony was set up. He was also involved with Gang shows and the Wesley Players - including the famous production of Flippity and the Penguin as Mr Maestro.

Both remained in the local church community until they moved to the Old Railway Station in Thorpe Waterville following Keith's work at Pearl Assurance in 1988.

They were very fond of their friends from the Upminster area and stayed in touch with many of them.

Menna died in 2022 and Keith moved to a smaller house in Thrapston, just round the corner from Bethan. He celebrated his 90th birthday last year with all 10 of his grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren in attendance - half of them from overseas!

He died peacefully on Monday 6th October in hospital after a short illness with his two daughters and 5 grandchildren with him.

Our thoughts and prayers are with all the family at this time.
