The District Attorney's Office chairs the task force, a group comprised of 19 organizations, that seeks to prevent trafficking and rehabilitate survivors. Our Village Closet (OVC) improves outcomes for youth and families impacted by foster care by providing essentials, support, and community connections. A two-time JLNS grant recipient, OVC operates a "store" on Mendocino Ave providing new and gently used items for families in need. JUNIOR LEAGUE STATE PUBLIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE (SPAC)

It was another great year for the Junior Leagues of California State Public Affairs Committee (SPAC). SPAC is 17 California Leagues strong and represents over 6.500 League women who volunteer over 110,000 hours and spend over \$1.1 million to better their communities.

Your delegates Emily Hoover-Finnigan (outgoing Senior) and Margaret Sluyk (outgoing Junior / incoming Senior) worked hard to represent JLNS at the state level and to "bring SPAC home" to our JLNS membership.

During the League year, we heard from several Assembly members from across California and learned from key organizations about what policies matter to the work they do and how advocacy can play a key role in their important work.

Our delegates served as the treasurer and on the health committee. This year included in-person SPAC conferences and provided amazing opportunities to work together analyzing and advocating for legislation, and a great way to hear from so many legislators to understand SPAC for what we are: a well-respected and hardworking force, advocating for our state's most vulnerable people.

This year, SPAC supported over 12 pieces of legislation in the areas of Health, Family Support, Education, Anti-Human Trafficking, and Violence Prevention. SPAC delegates will continue to monitor the status of the bills they are supporting.

Through advocacy, community outreach, and the development of ourselves as leaders, we can make a real and lasting impact. Thank you for supporting our League's participation in SPAC as part of that ongoing impact.
