Career Enrichment Program Day

This morning, join the leader and national guide at the hotel for an **orientation and cultural briefing** on China. You will be briefed on the political and cultural diversity of the country and receive further information on the journey.

Begin your professional program with a visit to a local hospital such as **Beijing Guang'anmen Traditional Chinese Medicine Hospital**. The primary professional objective is to enhance understanding of China's health systems, both traditional and modern, including health promotion and disease prevention; explore the role of nurses and other healthcare professionals in providing health care; and examine China's culture and community while giving back to local community projects.

Accompanying guests:

This afternoon guests will explore the largest and bestpreserved royal garden in China. The **Summer Palace** has been an urban oasis for hundreds of years and was restored to its original splendor in the early 20th century.

Professional Program Day

Today, the professional members of the group will meet with staff and faculty from a local **nursing school** as well as visit the **Beijing Massage Hospital**.

Established in 1958, the hospital is a training center for Chinese and international students offering courses to doctors, physical therapists, and amateurs from different countries to get training on Chinese massage both through theoretical study and clinical observation. Some of the available classes include: Basic Theory of Chinese Traditional Medicine, Channels and Acupuncture Points, Chinese Massage Theoretical Study and Clinical Observation. During a tour of the hospital, **see how modern TCM is performed** in a traditional Chinese environment.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant today.

Accompanying guests:

This morning the accompanying guests will visit the **Temple of Heaven**. Emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasties visited these impressive structures to offer annual prayers to heaven for plentiful harvests. This afternoon guests will visit the **798 Art Zone** to meander through the exhibits and enjoy art from local artists.

Enjoy a traditional **Peking duck dinner** this evening at the Qianmen Quanjude Beijing Roast Duck Restaurant.

Iconic Cultural Sites of Beijing

Start your morning by entering the **Forbidden City** (Imperial Palace), whose massive stone walls and 9,999 rooms were once the residence of Ming and Qing emperors, and visit **Tiananmen Square**, the large plaza that has been the site of several key events in Chinese history.

Lunch will be provided at the Badaling Restaurant.

Later, consider the mysteries of construction and conquest that have drawn people to the **Great Wall of China** for nearly 2,000 years. Enjoy breathtaking views from the wall's high vantage points, and meander along a section set in a rugged, mountainous landscape.

You will have some time to relax this evening with dinner on your own arrangement.

Fly to Xi'an & Cooking Lesson

Depart Beijing for **Xi'an**. As one of the six ancient capitals of China, Xi'an served as an imperial seat for 1,120 years and is a world-famous treasure house of cultural relics. The renowned Silk Road, which connected East with West in ages past, started in Xi'an.

A light lunch service will be provided on your flight.

Transfer to the **Mercure Hotel** later today for check-in and some time to relax. The Mercure Hotel on Renmin Square is a four-star hotel and offers every convenience of a business hotel. Hotel rooms have free Wi-Fi, safe, hairdryer, bathroom amenities and every comfort you will need for your stay.

Professional Exchange & Humanitarian Visit

This morning, the professional members of the group will enjoy a visit to a **local hospital**.

Lunch will be provided at a local restaurant.

Head outside of the city to visit a **village clinic**. Spend time interacting with the staff in this unique setting while learning about the challenges of access to care facing the rural population.

This afternoon, the group will visit a **local community or non-profit organization** dedicated to giving back to the local people. Spend time learning about their organization and assist with a small project as needed.

Accompanying guests:

This morning guests will explore the **Xi'an City Wall**. This massive walled fortification was built back in the Ming Dynasty (14th century). Explore the battlements, towers and walk along the portions still existing in old town still today. After lunch you will visit the rural village with the rest of the group and take part in the humanitarian activity.

Cultural Exploration of Xi'an

Join your fellow travelers to come face-to-face with the **Terracotta Warriors**—8,000 life-sized figures of soldiers and horses standing guard over the tomb of Qin Shi Huangdi, the first emperor of a united China.

Lunch will be provided this afternoon.

Later today you will visit the **Grand Mosque**, one of the oldest, largest and best-preserved Islamic mosques in China.

Afterward visit a **local market** for a chance to meander independently and engage with the local people and perhaps pick up a few fun souvenirs.

Enjoy dinner tonight at a Dim Sum restaurant.

September 23: Day 9

Fly to Shanghai

This morning, say goodbye to Xi'an and make your way to the airport for your flight to **Shanghai**. Upon arrival, transfer to the Yu Garden area for lunch. After lunch, explore the **Yu Garden** bordering Old Town, filled with stone dragons, tea houses, pavilions, and goldfish ponds.

Narada Boutique Hotel is in the bustling core area of Huangpu District, close to Metro Line 8 & 10 stations and just a five-minute walk away from the Yu Garden and Huaihai Road.
