



Quote & History Tidbit

Christ is a substitute for everything, but nothing is a substitute for Christ.

Born: October 1876 Toronto, Ontario Canada

Dr. Ironside, aka "Harry" was a Canadian-American preacher, pastor, biblical theologian and author. At 16 the Salvation army allowed him to begin preaching and by17 as a SA commissioned lieutenant preaching over 500 sermons a year. Known as the "Archbishop of Fundamentalism" due to his popular dispensationalism in North America among Protestants. He is also considered one of the most prolific Christian writers of the 20th century with more than 100 books, pamphlets, booklets and commentaries still in print. One of the popular hymns entitled *Overshadowed* was also written by Harry. An editorial review was penned as "Ironside's commentaries are a standard and have stood the test of time."



Saturday: 6.9 - John 4:13-14


¹³ Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:
