Community Garden Center Initiative Guidelines:

- I will not be in the garden before sunrise or after sunset
- I will have something planted in the garden by June 30th
- If I must abandon my plot for any reason, I will notify the RLAC
- I will keep weeds down and maintain the areas immediately surrounding my plot
- I will not use fertilizers, insecticides or weed repellants that will affect other plots
- I will be given a warning and one week to cleanup an unkempt plot
- I will help pick up trash and debris in the garden area as needed
- I will harvest only my own crops
- No pets allowed in the garden space
- The use of water from both water sources is provided as a service by the RLAC and partners. It is to be conserved and used only by gardeners for the purpose of watering the garden
- Post season clean up will be the responsibility of all gardeners with plots

It is the mission of the Rock Lake Activity Center to positively affect the health and wellness of the community through quality programming and activities.
