Agnes L. Mzyk, age 83, of Elkton, died Sunday evening, April 18, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility.

She was born May 17, 1915, in Shamokin, PA to the late William and Pauline (Derlon) Gryskiewicz and moved to Michigan in 1938.
