

What to Bring List

The following is a list of items your children should bring to camp. Please be sure that **ALL** of your child's belongings have their name or initials on them. Since most of your child's time will be spent outside we recommend old, comfortable clothing. Please be aware of the weather for the week that your child will be attending camp. We hold outdoor activities during all seasons and all types of weather, including rain, snow, and mud.

All Seasons:



- ~ Jacket
- ~ Pajamas
- ~ Pants
- ~ Rain Poncho/Rain Coat
- ~ Shirts (long and short sleeve)
- ~ Shoes (2 pr and 1 needs to be tennis shoes)
- ~ Socks (multiple pairs)
- ~ Underwear

Summer Gear:



- ~ Swimsuit – Girls **No** 2 piece suits
- ~ Beach Towel
- ~ Flip Flops or sandals for the beach
- ~ Insect Repellent
- ~ Sunscreen

Sleeping Gear:



- ~ Pillow
- ~ Sleeping Bag
- ~ Stuffed Animal (if desired)

Personal Items:

- ~ Comb/Brush

Optional Items:

If attending any of the following camps please bring the items noted for the camp:
