



## **FACT SHEET – VISITOR EXPECTATIONS**

**ALL visitations will be outdoors, weather permitting  
A visitation area has been set up with a separate visitors entrance/screening area**

**ALL visitors are screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, including temperature check, screening questions/assessment**

**Visitation will be refused if the individual(s) exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms or does not pass the screening questions.**

**A rapid test will be offered/done on the date of the visit as part of the screening**

**Visitation will be scheduled in two, 60-minute sessions**

**10:30 AM to 11:30 AM & 1:30 PM to 2:30 PM**

**by resident unit, Monday through Friday as follows:**

**Monday – 4<sup>th</sup> Floor**

**Tuesday – 5<sup>th</sup> Floor**

**Wednesday – 6<sup>th</sup> Floor**

**Thursday – 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor**

**Friday – 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor**

**For those situations where both the visitor(s) and the resident have been fully vaccinated, specific sessions will be designated to visit without barriers & allow physical contact if the resident wishes.**

**ALL VISITATION MUST BE SCHEDULED IN ADVANCE**

**Visitation is limited to two (2) persons per resident due to space limitations**

**Visitors will be asked to use hand-sanitizer when they arrive for the visit**

**Visitors must wear a face mask or covering that always covers the nose & mouth when on the premises of the nursing home**

**Social distancing, as marked in the visiting area, must be always maintained**

**Food & beverages may not be consumed during the visit as this would require mask removal**

**Staff will escort the resident to the visit and monitor the visit**

**If any visitor tests positive or is quarantined due to COVID exposure in the 14 days following visitation, the facility must be notified immediately.**
