Dorothy J. Lee, 88, of Caseville, passed away Tuesday, September 28, 2004, at Home Sweet Home Retirement Manor in Pigeon. Born in Vassar on July 22, 1916, she was the daughter of late Elmer and Hattie (Goodman) Titsworth. She graduated from Vassar High School in 1934.
