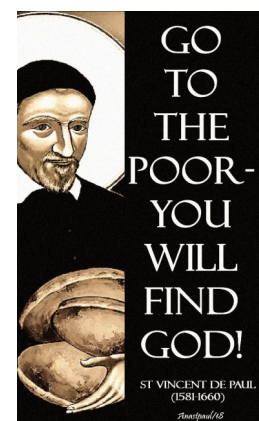
GREAT NEWS

REVISIT THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Pope Francis' intention for the month March offers a timely focus on the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It's a message full of hope, in which he invites us to rediscover the power of personal renewal that the Sacrament of Confession has in our life. "Let us pray that we may experience the Sacrament of Reconciliation with renewed depth, to taste the forgiveness and infinite mercy of God". Jesus waits for us, listens to us and forgives us". "In the heart of God, we come before our mistakes high lighting once more the power God's love has over our being and action. Receiving this Sacrament isn't a matter of standing before a judge, but of going to a loving encounter with a Father who receives us and always forgives us. "The center of confession is not the sins we declare, but the divine love we receive, of which we are always in need," the Pope adds. And this love comes before all else, before our mistakes, the rules, judgments and failings. When we go to confession, it is in order to be healed, to heal our soul; To leave with greater spiritual health; To pass from misery to mercy.
