April 9, 2026

Pledge of Allegiance: 7:00 PM

Secretary's Report: Minutes from the March 2026 meeting was read by Mike Wyckoff. Motion was made and minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Cal Roberts provided the April 2026 Treasurer's Report. Motion was made and Treasurer's Report was approved.

Membership Report: 9 Board of Directors, 14 Reduced Rate Members and 285 Social Members for a total of 308 out of the 350 limit. There are 40 Life Members, 1 Honorary and 2 Junior for an additional 43 with total of 351.

There were no new member applications for this month.

Dan Grey reported that Youth Archery will be held this Saturday, April 11th. The club provides the instruction and the equipment. Equipment is the same as that used in the schools. Age limits are 6-16.

Dan Charles discussed Youth Shooting. A letter will be sent to members for ideas to increase participation.

Work Day items:

- Cleanup of dirt on Pistol Range #1 to prep for mowing
- Collect trash and bring to burn pile by Archery building
- Remove algae clumps from lake
- Empty trash cans on ranges

There are enough volunteers to cut grass and weed whack the property that outside vendors will not be used. Points are given to these volunteers to reduce their membership rates for next year.

Tony McClure reports that since the installation of drywall on the ceiling, the Indoor Range is louder when weapons are discharged. Installation of sound deadening materials will probably be required. Members sensitive to this will need to use double hearing protection.
