Regular Meeting -----May 5, 1987

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, ATTENDANCE  
D. L. Taylor at 7:00 A.M. Other Grand County Water Conser-  
vancy District members present were Gary Wilson, John Smith  
and John Groo.

Grand County Special Service District members  
present were D.L. Taylor, Gary Wilson, George White and  
William D. McDougald.

Others present were Joe Chacon, Dale Pierson, and  
Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of April MINUTES  
21, 1987 meeting, together with the notes of the joint  
meeting on April 22, 1987. The joint meeting was discussed,  
and metering the golf course service. Gary stated his  
opinion was that at the meeting the Golf Course Board had  
agreed to pay for all water used.

Dale reported he had talked to the University and WATER USE AT  
they estimated golf course use was comparable to alfalfa, it GOLF COURSE  
used less water, but since there is no downtime for cutting,  
the season use would be about the same.

George White moved to sell 400 AF to the golf COST TO GOLF  
course at \$22.50 per acre foot with the built in raises for COURSE  
5 years. The question arose as to is the golf course to pay  
for water up front like every one else or if they are on a  
meter, will they want to pay for it as they use it. Bill  
McDougald suggested the Board be flexible, at least for the  
first year. Gary seconded George's motion. The discussion  
about the terms of payments and budget can be negotiated at  
a meeting, suggesting the Golf Course Board follow our  
system of collecting all revenue in January.

Joe Chacon stated he wants to buy 1-1/2 acres of JOE CHACON  
water, and would like to make arrangements for making pay- REQUEST  
ments. D.L. explained there had been a moratorium on water  
in his area. Dale has a couple of concerns. We must also  
keep in mind we are sold out of water, he has made some  
notes on selling "supplemental water". How many customers  
should we hook up on this basis is a concern. The rules and  
figures from the Division of Water Resources were discussed.  
George moved we sell water to the people on the waiting list  
at this time. Dale explained the use of well water to  
supplement delivery to Moab Irrigation Co., and the acres  
irrigated and the use suggested by the Division of Water  
Resources. Gary stated he had no objections to selling  
water, but that it should be on a conditional contract that  
provides that if we have a low water year, we would not be  
responsible. George moved the District sell water to the  
waiting list now between P.R. #1 and #2 and not sell any

more water until it becomes available. Bill seconded. After discussion, MOTION CARRIED.

The right of way for the irrigation line was RIGHT-OF-WAY discussed briefly, and Dale reported the pipe has been ordered. Dale also reported we had received no money from the C.I.B., but they report we still have the grant.

The financial statement was reviewed and discussed. FINANCIAL STATEMENT ADJOURNMENT

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 A.M.
