Ordinance O-2017- 40

AN ORDINANCE HIRING DUSTIN WADE AS A PERMANENT PART TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR AMELIA VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2017, the Amelia Village Council enacted Ordinance No. O-2017-14, appointing Dustin Wade the position of part-time police officer; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Amelia Village acknowledges the successful completion of the probationary period required by Ohio Revised Code Section 737.17 by Officer Dustin Wade, the transmittal by the Mayor of a record of Officer Wade's service during the probationary period and the Mayor's recommendation to affirm the appointment of Dustin Wade as a part-time police officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. Council hereby concurs with the recommendation by the Mayor to affirm the appointment of Dustin Wade as a part-time police officer for Amelia Village.

SECTION II. Dustin Wade is hereby employed as a part-time police officer of Amelia Village effective December 12, 2017.

SECTION III. All prior Resolutions and Ordinances or any part thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said Resolutions or Ordinances not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberation of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such a necessity is that the Police Department of Amelia Village has several vacant police officer positions and this appointment will allow the Village to provide the necessary police protection to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.

MS. DANIEL seconded the motion.




