





#### Jim Skipper's Cut Time Rhythm Sheet

## All State Sight Reading Thoughts

- Very Few Play Stylistically
- Very Few Perform Articulation Patterns Correctly
- A Slight Few Play The Correct Dynamics
- Many Have Trouble Keeping The Pulse
- Many Don't Subdivide (16<sup>th</sup>'s For Example)
- Students Often Miss 2 Foot Pat Patterns
- Unfortunately Some Do Not Have A Characteristic Tone


