II. God made it possible for us to put our faith onto real evidence.

A. Jesus appears to His disciples:

Luke 24:36–43 — ³⁶ *While they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst and said to them, “Peace be to you.”* ³⁷ *But they were startled and frightened and thought that they were seeing a spirit.*

³⁸ *And He said to them, “Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?”* ³⁹ *“See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself; touch Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have.”* ⁴⁰ *And when He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet.*

⁴¹ *While they still could not believe it because of their joy and amazement, He said to them, “Have you anything here to eat?”* ⁴² *They gave Him a piece of a broiled fish;* ⁴³ *and He took it and ate it before them.”*

B. What greater proof would we need if we were them?

III. Lessons from the Resurrection of Christ:

A. Resurrection gives us hope beyond the grave: Paul said...

1 Thessalonians 4:13 — ¹³ *But we do not want you to be uninformed, brethren, about those who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as do the rest who have no hope.”*

1. The Gentiles grieved terribly for their deceased loved ones.
2. They lived in constant fear of death.

B. Resurrection answers all the questions about the after-life.

1. What happens to people after they die?
2. Where do they go?
3. Will we ever see them again?
4. How does our earthly life affect us in the here-after?
5. Who is in charge of the resurrection?

C. Resurrection validates all the teachings of Christ as true in every way.

John 2:18–19 — ¹⁸ *The Jews then said to Him, “What sign do You show us as your authority for doing these things?”* ¹⁹ *Jesus answered them, “Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.”* ... ²¹ *But He was speaking of the temple of His body.*

1. It shows that our faith in Christ is true and unshakeable
-1 Corinthians 15:16-17
2. God has placed His seal of authenticity on Christ’s ministry when He raised Him from the dead.

D. Resurrection vindicates the urgency of sharing the Gospel message. - Jesus commissions His disciples.

Luke 24:46–47 — ⁴⁶ *and He said to them, “Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day,* ⁴⁷ *and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem.”*

1. **Gospel:** Turn away from your sins (repent) and believe in the resurrected Savior as the new Lord over your life.
2. **Question:** Have you had experience sharing the gospel?
