- II. God made it possible for us to put our faith onto real evidence.
 - A. Jesus appears to His disciples:

Luke 24:36–43 — "³⁶ While they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be to you." ³⁷ But they were startled and frightened and thought that they were seeing a spirit.

³⁸ And He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? ³⁹ "See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself; touch Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." ⁴⁰ And when He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet.

⁴¹ While they still could not believe it because of their joy and amazement, He said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?" ⁴² They gave Him a piece of a broiled fish; ⁴³ and He took it and ate it before them."

III. Lessons from the Resurrection of Christ:

A. Resurrection gives us hope beyond the grave: Paul said...

- **1 Thessalonians 4:13** "¹³ But we do not want you to be uninformed, brethren, about those who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as do the rest who have no hope."
 - 1. The Gentiles grieved terribly for their deceased loved ones.
 - 2. They lived in constant fear of death.

C. Resurrection validates all the teachings of Christ as true in every way.

John 2:18–19 — "¹⁸ The Jews then said to Him, "What sign do You show us as your authority for doing these things?" ¹⁹ Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."" ... ²¹ But He was speaking of the temple of His body.

- 1. It shows that our faith in Christ is true and unshakeable
 -1 Corinthians 15:16-17
- 2. God has placed His seal of authenticity on Christ's ministry when He raise Him from the dead.
- **D.** Resurrection vindicates the urgency of sharing the Gospel message. Jesus commissions His disciples.

Luke 24:46–47 — "⁴⁶ and He said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day, ⁴⁷ and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem."

- 1. **Gospel:** Turn away from your sins (repent) and believe in the resurrected Savior as the new Lord over your life.
- 2. Question: Have you had experience sharing the gospel?
