# Israel Itinerary

We will spend time in the Dead Sea area and visit Masada. Jerusalem brings excitement as we will see the Western Wall and visit the Mt. of Olives. You will also have the opportunity to visit the region of the Coast.

This tour includes airfare, hotels with breakfast and dinners, comfortable A/C coach, transfers, entrance fees, a scholarly guide, and many extras at one price that individual travel cannot match. Join Pastor Scott on this exciting and spiritual pilgrimage to Israel.

**Israel, March 7-18, 2024**

**Day 1 TH** Depart U.S. for flight to Israel.

**Day 2 F** Arrive Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport. Meet our guide and transfer to hotel. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

**Day 3 S** Late start from hotel. Begin by visiting David's Tomb and the Upper Room. Possibly view the grave of Oskar Schindler. Continue to Mt. Zion; St. Peter's in Gallicantu, which is built over the site of the house of the High Priest Caiaphas and the stone pit where Jesus was held. Three times, Peter also denied knowing Jesus near this same place. After lunch, visit the Garden Tomb, with devotion and communion time. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

**Day 4 S** Early morning start. Drive south along the Dead Sea. Take a cable-car to the top of Masada to view the fortress of Herod. Proceed to the ruins of the ancient Essene settlement at Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. There will be a time for devotion and lunch. You will then enjoy floating in the Dead Sea. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

**Day 5 M** Begin the day by visiting Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum. You will then continue to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. Enjoy a lunch at the Grotto. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

**Day 6 T** Start the day by visiting the Temple Mount, Western Wall, and Western Wall Tunnel. After lunch, visit the Davidson Center, with devotional time on the teaching steps. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

**Day 7 W** Mt. of Olives; Church of the Ascension, then begin the "Palm Sunday" walk, stopping at Pater Noster Church, commemorating Jesus' teaching His disciples the Lord's Prayer and Dominus Flevit, ending in the Garden of Gethsemene, the place of Jesus' agony, betrayal and arrest, and Church of All Nations, which contains the rock where Jesus is believed to have prayed before His betrayal and arrest. Allow for devotional time. After lunch, visit the Pool of Bethesda and then begin the Via Dolorosa/Way of the Cross. End the Way of the Cross in the Holy Sepulchre. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

**Day 8 TH** Check out of the hotel. Begin the day by visiting Wadi Qelt to view the ancient road from Jerusalem to Jericho. In Jericho, you will visit Tel es Sultan; the ancient city of Jericho and view the Mt. of Temptation. After lunch, continue driving north through the Jordan Valley, stopping at Beit She'an, the ancient biblical city, which the Greeks and Romans knew as Scythopolis. Overnight in Galilee region.

**Day 9 F** Early morning start. Begin the day by visiting Mt. Tabor, site of the Transfiguration. Continue to Nazareth to visit Elbabour Spice Shop, Mary's Well, and Ancient Bath House. After lunch, continue to Cana, Wedding Church with vow renewals. Overnight in Galilee region.

**Day 10 S** Sea of Galilee, including: the Mount of Beatitudes; Tabgha, the place of Jesus' miracle of the Multiplication of the Fish and Loaves, Capernaum: known as "Jesus' hometown." We will also take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and enjoy a St. Peter's Fish lunch. Stop by Yardenit; Jordan River at the end of the day. Overnight in Galilee.

**Day 11 S** Check out of hotel. Drive to Caesarea Maritima and aqueduct. Continue to Tel Aviv, with early afternoon arrival. You will be allowed free time. If you are staying overnight in Tel Aviv, you will not be allowed to check in until after 3:00 PM. You will be picked up at the hotel for the farewell dinner in the evening. If you have a late evening flight, you will not go to the hotel. You will have free time and farewell dinner, and then be taken to the airport.

**Day 12 M** Arrive back to the U.S.
