

OPERATION MANUAL FOR THE PS15 BELT SKIVER

THE SKIVER HAS 5 SETTINGS ON THE DIAL: (#0 - #4)

0 is OFF

- 1. MAKE SURE THE INDICATOR IS ON THE (#0) SETTING WHEN YOU ARE INSTALLING THE BLADES and WHEN THE PRODUCT IS NOT IN USE. 0 is OFF. ****Failing to do so may result in possibly getting burned
- 2. LOOSEN THE TWO SET SCREWS IN THE HEAD AND INSTALL THE BLADE IN THE HEAD.
- 3. BY INSERTING THE BLADE INTO THE SLOTS THAT ARE IN THE BRASS ENDS (THE SHARP EDGE IS FACING AWAY AS YOU ARE PUSHING THE BLADE NOT PULLING IT)
- 4. USING THE 4MM ALLEN WRENCH THAT IS INCLUDED. ADJUST THE DEPTH BY SLIDING THE BLADE UP AND DOWN IN THE HEAD. ***GO AS DEEP AS YOU WANT TO, BUT DO NOT CUT INTO THE FABRIC. (CAUTION: DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN THE SET SCREWS AS THIS WILL STRIP OUT THE NUTS) ****Important: USE THE LONG END OF THE ALLEN WRENCH AS IT WILL HELP YOU AVOID THE TEMPTATION TO OVER TIGHTEN.
- 5. IF YOU ARE INSTALLING THE SUPER-SCREW CONVEYOR BELT FASTENER, WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU INSTALL IT ON A BIAS OF ONE INCH PER FOOT OF BELT WIDTH (36 inches wide/3 inch bias) AND SKIVING AS MUCH OF THE TOP AS POSSIBLE. ONLY SKIVE THE BOTTOM IF THERE IS ENOUGH RUBBER TO SKIVE.

 ****YOU NEED A MINIMUM OF 3/16" OF BELT THICKNESS FOR THE SUPER-SCREW TO WORK PROPERLY. Note: THIS SEATS THE INTERNAL NUT INTO THE BOTTOM FO THE BELT.
- 6. MARK THE BELT WITH A CHALK LINE OR BELT PEN TO THE DEPTH OF YOUR CUT. **See Super-Screw instructions for measuring this distance for skiving back on the leading and trailing edge.
- 7. THIS IS THE START POINT FOR SKIVING. (THE BLADE DOES NOT GET HOT UNTIL YOU PUSH ON IT)
- START YOUR SKIVING WITH THE PS15 ON A SETTING OF (#3) UNTIL YOU GET ACQUAINTED WITH HOW THE TOOL WORKS. AFTER YOU GET STARTED, YOU CAN CHANGE TO THE (#4) SETTING. WE RECOMMEND THE W6 BLADE THAT IS 7/8" WIDE FOR THE MAXIMUM WIDTH OF THE CUT. SKIVE ALL THE WAY ACROSS THE BELT AND THEN COME BACK AND START AGAIN. ***SKIP 1/8" OF THE RUBBER AND SKIVE THE WHOLE 7/8" IF YOU DO NOT DO THIS YOU WILL BURN UP THE BLADES. YOU WILL COME BACK AND GET THIS 1/8" ROW, AFTER ADJUSTING THE TEMP BACK DOWN TO THE #1 SETTING. Note: IF THE BLADE IS SMOKING YOU ARE GOING TO SLOW OR YOU ARE NOT CUTTING THE FULL 7/8". DO NOT JERK THE HANDLE BACK WHEN TAKING BREAKS. SIMPLY TURN THE TOOL LOOSE AND LET IT COOL. AFTER YOU HAVE MADE AS MANY 7/8" PASSES AS POSSIBLE, (ALWAYS LEAVING A SMALL 1/8" UNCUT ROW) TURN THE SETTING ON THE PS 15 SKIVER DOWN TO THE (#1) SETTING AND CLEAN UP THE 1/8" ROWS OF RUBBER THAT YOU LEFT.
- 9. THIS WILL GO REAL FAST, REMEMBER TO NOT LET YOUR BLADE SMOKE. THIS MEANS THAT THE TOOL IS GETTING TOO HOT.
