

REV. FR. EUGENE SEIDENWAND

1922 - 1996

Rev. Fr. Eugene Seidenwand, 74, formerly of Sebawang, died Monday, Oct. 6 in Botolph Hospital, Farmington Hills.

He was born in Flint, Feb. 5, 1922, the son of Harry and Susan (O'Dea) Seidenwand. He graduated from St. Michael High School, Flint, attended Sacred Heart Seminary, Detroit, St. Mary Seminary, Cincinnati, and St. John Provincial Seminary.

He was ordained June 2, 1955 for the Saginaw Diocese and during his 40-year priesthood was called by the Bishop to 15 parish assignments throughout the Saginaw Diocese, of which nearly seven years were at Holy Family Catholic Church of Sebawang, from June, 1976 to February, 1983.

He is survived by four sisters, two brothers, 34 nieces and nephews, 62 great nieces and nephews, seven great great nieces and nephews and many cousins.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by a sister.

The Funeral Mass took place at 11 a.m. Friday, Oct. 11 in St. Michael Catholic Church, Flint, with Most Rev. Kenneth Untener, Fr. Michael Maher, Fr. James O'Meara and fellow priests officiating. Burial was in New Calvary Catholic Cemetery.
