### A Daily Quiet Time With God Built America

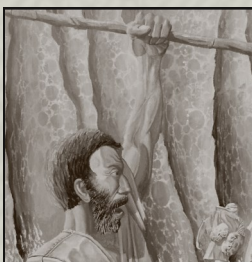

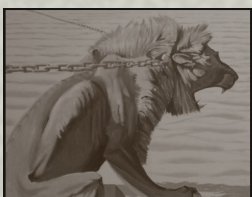
*Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much -James 5:16*



# The Capital City Rescue Mission in Albany, NY

## The Help It Gave Me

The [Capital City Rescue Mission](#) started on Green Street in downtown Albany at around (year) and was known for its soup kitchen. Patterned after the White Street and Bowery Missions in New York City, the CCRM has helped many men who either lost all they had in property, were displaced from their property or never had any property.

In 1997 I found myself in that category of men having lost my property and rented housing when I was living in Albany. That was the first time. I returned about twice after that to the Capital City Rescue Mission, both at the Green Street location and its new location on S. Pearl St., until I was able to secure a more permanent housing. The mission taught principles from the Bible and it gave me a place to get off the street. I actually had *nowhere else to go*. Few people wind up in that state, as we do not think much about what it is like to be homeless. The mission has a policy that you have to have a valid ID to be admitted, which I disagree with, but they do give you a chance to

find other housing. You can see what services they provide now by going to the link, and the basic premise remains: housing, food and connection to other services like medical care in a time of homelessness.

An inner city mission that uses a KJV is very effective at translating the power of God for a man who may have need to repent of his vices, which was not necessarily my case. I never had a problem with drugs or alcohol, but I have a medical condition that effected my ability to work and operate a household.

The “Jesus Saves” sign on the mission building reflects the same sign at the [White Street Mission](#) in NYC—a guide for the homeless man to find a place where he can eat, sleep and get the help he needs to change his life with the power of God.
