

**OLSON J. McCALLUM**  
**1926 - 1998**

Olson J. McCallum age 71, of Grant Twp. near Elkton died Thursday evening, March 5, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility, after struggling with Parkinson's Disease for many years.

He was born June 8, 1926 in Denver, CO and moved to Grant Township while a child with his parents, the late Frank and Luella (Wolf) McCallum.

On February 14, 1948, he was united in marriage to Ila M. Morley at the Owendale Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saint Church.

After returning from service in the Navy during WW II, he attended Michigan State 2 years. In 1948, he hired in at Active Industries, where he was the steel controller, retiring in 1991 after 43 years of service. He also raised fruit trees and sold apples, pears and grapes for many years.

Mr. McCallum started the Active Credit Union (currently Team One) in his home where he operated it over five years before it move in to Elkton.

Olson was a member of the Owendale R.L.D.S. Church, past president of the Elkton Rotary Club, former elder and pastor of the Caseville, Owendale and Bad Axe R.L.D.S. Churches and the Parkinson's Support Group, Cass City.

Surviving are his wife, Ila; two sons, Larry (Grace) McCallum of Port Austin and Dennis (Elizabeth) McCallum of San Francisco, CA; three daughters, Rosie McCallum-Herbert of Pigeon, Suzie (Phil) Cochrane of Guelph, ONT and Shelly (Keith) Lelacheur of Burkbennett, TX; seven, grandchildren, Scott, Jody, Jenny, Dalen, Josh, Spencer and T.J.

A son, Randy; his brother, Don and sister, Veta Hereim, preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted 1:00 PM Monday, March 9, at the Owendale R.L.D.S. Church, 5 miles south of Elkton. Elders Ellis Gardner and Ervin Haley will officiate with military graveside honor, by the Carpenter-Dorsch VFW Post #6013, at Grant Twp. Cemetery.
