Meeting of the DeKalb County Commission

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee, West District Commissioner Kyle White and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison led all in attendance in prayer with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to accept the agenda as presented with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the minutes from the April 2nd meeting with East District Commissioner, Garry McFee making the second. Motion carried.

Dallas Township member, David Brown met with the Commission to discuss roads, gravel tubes and roads they will gravel this year.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented the General Municipal Election results to the Commission concerning the Sales Tax Rock issue. Melissa told the group the issue passed in all townships. The Commission would like to thank everyone for the passage of this tax as it continues to help all townships with rock that is applied to the DeKalb County roads. This tax has been in place since 1985. This year the Commission has approved 120 ton to the mile on all roads.

Sheriff Andy Clark met with the Commission to discuss vehicles, happenings around the County and thanked the Commission for always being supportive of his office. It was also discussed that County Clerk, Melissa Meek would put the 2015 Ford Explorer out for bids with the starting bid at \$13,500.00. Clinton County Sheriff's department had indicated they wanted the vehicle but have made no contact with the Clerk's office. Bids will be opened on said vehicle May 7th at 11 a.m.

A patron was in to voice concerns over a landowner placing electric fence posts and equipment in the right-of-way. Sheriff Clark will go talk to said landowner and report back to the Commission.

The new flag pole will be installed this week weather permitting. Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray has requested the old one be placed at the County Barn.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission to discuss equipment and that a land owner had requested the width of a bridge be expanded so his large farm equipment could cross said bridge. The Commission agreed to widen the bridge rails to allow him to cross.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek called the Secretary of State's Office concerning the position of Full time prosecutor being placed on the ballot. More information continues to be gathered concerning this and will be ready to be placed on the ballot in the Primary Election August 7th.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to adjourn with Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison made the second. Motion carried.
