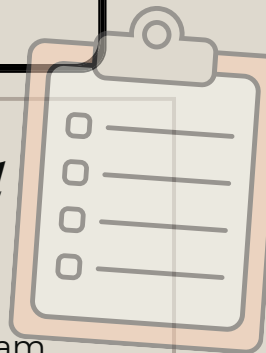

## *Celebrating Juneteenth*



Juneteenth (short for "June Nineteenth") marks the day when federal troops arrived in Galveston, Texas in 1865 to take control of the state and ensure that all enslaved people be freed and came 2 1/2 years after the signing of the Emancipation Proclamation. Juneteenth honors the end to slavery in the US and is considered the longest-running African American holiday. It is sometimes called "Freedom Day," "Juneteenth Independence Day," or "Emancipation Day." There are many books and resources for adults and children to learn and celebrate Juneteenth.
