Maifest Dancing Begins Friday Evening Maipole Performance Schedule for the Weekend

A community dress rehearsal for the Amana Maipole Dancers will be held Friday, May 1 at 6:15 p.m. at the Colonial Manor Care Facility. This Friday evening performance for the residents of the facility and for Lakeview Village has become a Maipole Dancers tradition.

At 7 p.m. on Friday the Maipole Dancers will be at Millstream Brewing Co. for the Maibock release party. The event starts at 5 p.m. and will feature the dancers at 7 p.m. Look forward to seeing Die Tiefen Keller Kinder kick off the Amana festival season Friday!

Saturday the Amana Maipole folk dancers will perform at 11 a.m. at the Festhalle; 11:45 at the Amana Heritage Museum; 12:15 at the Amana General Store; 1:30 p.m. at the Festhalle barn; 2 p.m. at the Amana Meat Shop; 2:30 at Millstream Brau Haus.

On Sunday the dancers will perform at 11 a.m. at the Amana Meat Shop and Smokehouse; 12:15 at the Amana General Store and 1 p.m. at the Blüten Haus. Should it be raining Maipole performances are held inside the Festhalle.

Maifest, Yourfest, Ourfest is Here

In 1992 RC Eichacker decided we ought to have a Maifest celebration and then made it happen by organizing the first ten or so Maifests. His dream was a spring celebration of Amana folk art, dance and music.

This year Eichacker will be our Maifest Parade Grand Marshall.

The parade theme is America 250 honoring our American veterans. Eichacker, who is a veteran of the Navy, served on the Battleship Iowa. The parade takes place Saturday at 10 a.m. on Amana's main street and back street.

There will be kids stuff on the Party patio of the Festhalle (north end of the barn) Saturday after the parade till 5. Face painting (concludes at 4) and POParrizi Design Balloon display and photo booth. (11 - 5)

This year one of our very favorite bands, Alpensterne, is here for Maifest! Normally an Oktoberfest mainstay, this delightful German festival band will be performing in the Festhalle from 11:45 a.m. until 1:15 p.m. on Saturday only.

At 1:30 p.m. on Saturday the Maipole dance troupe performs followed by the RTD Irish Step Dancers at 2:15 p.m. At 3:30 the band BNTB will perform.

Saturday from 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. several pop-up food trucks are expected at the Amana Festhalle along with the Amana Heritage Society's annual celebration of Amana Colony food with their yummy

homemade, potato pancakes and apple sauce and slices of fruit custard kuchen. To embrace the festival, you must go and enjoy these foods with the Amana Heritage Society. Volunteers will be hard at work and your support raises funds for the Amana Heritage Society's ongoing effort to preserve and share our Amana story.

Sunday from 10 - 4 p.m. adults may take part in the Amana wine and beer walk. \$5 supports the event and allows you samples from the five wineries and breweries on the walk. The first 275 people to complete the walk return their "stamped passports" to the Amana Visitor Center to a festival logo wine glass and to be entered to win an Amana gift certificate.

Millstream Brewing Co. Maifest Party is 9 a.m. - 10 pm. Live music including Barry Boyce Polka Band, Josh Sinclair pop up bbq with County Line and food from our own Brau Haus!

Ox Yoke Inn lawn party starts at 9 a.m. with parade refreshments on the front lawn of the Ox Yoke Inn.
