## ordinance no. 97-6A

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING HIRING STANDARDS FOR FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

The appointment of full-time and part-time police officers is to be made from applicants who, at the time of their appointment, are eligible for employment in the United States; are not less than 21 years of age; possess a high school diploma, equivalency certificate issued by the County Superintendent of Schools, or a diploma based on a GED Certificate; and have successfully been certified according to Section 8.2 the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/8.2) and shall be trained under the Intergovernmental Law Enforcement Officers' In-Service Training Act (50 ILCS 720/1 et. seq.). In addition, applicants shall be required to successfully pass such background tests, mental and physical tests and examinations as may be prescribed by the Village of Chapin. Neither full-time nor part-time police officers are required to reside within the limits of the Village of Chapin.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication in pamphlet form.
