## SECTION 1. TITLE

This local law shall be known as Local Law No. 1 for the year 1996 and will reschedule the date for hearing complaints by the board of assessment review pursuant to Sections 512 and 576 of the Real Property Tax Law.

### SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Local Law is to reschedule the date for the hearing of complaints by the assessment board of review from the fourth Tuesday of May to the fourth Thursday of May.

#### SECTION 3.

The Town of Hampton, Washington County, New York, and the Town of Kingsbury, Washington County, New York, has pursuant to Section 576 of the Real Property Tax Law appointed the same person to hold the office of sole assessor.

#### SECTION 4.

Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 576 of the Real Property Tax Law, the Town of Hampton provides that from and after the effective date of this local law, beginning on the fourth Thursday of May and so many days thereafter as the bard of assessment review deems necessary, such board shall meet to hear complaints in relation to assessments.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
