- ⇒ Pets must be at least 4 months old, as younger animals have weak or no immune systems.
- ⇒ Remember this is for fun! Event will be held at Founders Park to help protect paws from hot pavement. There is a bottle filler, drinking fountain and pet bowl fountain onsite. Hand washing onsite.
