**6:43pm** – Plag HaMincha Those accepting Shabbat at Plag HaMincha must complete Mincha before 6:43pm and can daven Ma'ariv after 6:43pm

**7:00pm** – Mincha / Kabbalat Shabbat

(Families who daven Mincha at 7:00pm should light candles by 7:15pm)

**7:55pm** – Candle Lighting

**8:00pm** – Mincha / Kabbalat Shabbat

- The bracha "Me'ein sheva" (including Magen Avot) is omitted when davening alone; Vayichulu is said, followed by Aleinu

**Tonight Omer 44** – Sefirat HaOmer after 8:14pm

### Shabbat

**Shacharit** – You may want to daven Shacharit at the same time that you typically do on Shabbat, or say the Amida of Shacharit at Netz, which is 5:31am

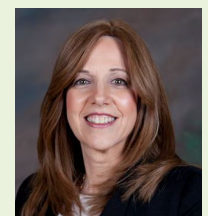

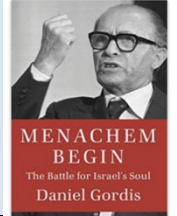

**Mincha:** Earliest time to daven Mincha – 1:30pm

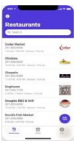
**Sunset:** Finish davening Mincha before sunset
