An OTC Member's Land Speed Record


OTC member *Martin Doerfler* set a Land Speed Record of 115.081 mph in the A-PG Class (push-rod gas powered) at the Bonneville Salt Flats in 2008 on a Triumph 500 cc. (Martin was age 68 at the time!)

The Triumph was built with a late style 500 Daytona engine in a lengthened and lowered 1971 Oil in Frame. It had XL 250 Honda front forks, Kawasaki wheels, glass by Bret Edwards Glass from the Past. Best run at Bonneville was 118-ish in 2006, unable to back it up. Best at El Mirage dry lake was 121 plus. Set the Bonneville record of 115.081 in 2008.




