BISMARCK HIGH: The Demons' (2016: 4-10-2 Overall; 3-7-2 WDA) Madison Burgard, and Madison Federer were named to the all-WDA team.

CENTURY: The Patriots (2016: 16-2-0 Overall; 11-1-0 WDA) swept three EDC foes en route to the ND State Soccer Tournament title last week in Mandan. Century posted three shutouts along the way, defeating West Fargo, 4-0, in first round; Fargo North, 2-0, in the semifinals and Fargo Davies, 1-0, in the championship.

Against WF, Calista Moch's deked and scored around the Packer netminder in the 17th minute to stake Century to a 1-0 advantage. Taryn Neameyer would strike four minutes later to stretch the lead. The match would remain that way until the closing minutes when Lexi Gura and Hannah Richter would tally for Century. Goalkeeper Alisa Betz made nine saves, including a few key ones in the second half when WF mounted a charge. Against FN, L. Gura's goal in the 10th minute proved to be the only one the Pats would need. H. Richter netted one in the second half. Century outshot the defending champions, 13-1. Against Davies, Kylee Welch put Century ahead with a goal from H. Richter just two minutes into the contest. Century continued to put pressure on in the second half, keeping the ball away from the Eagles top scorers. Goalkeeper A. Betz made four stops for Century which avenged an early season loss to the Eagles. Hannah Richter, Taryn Neameyer; Taylor Weeks, Tiffany Olhauser and Abby Westbee were named to the all-tournament team. Taryn Neameyer, Kylee Welch, Hannah Richter, Taylor Weeks, Tiffany Olhauser, Lauren Fleming and Calista Moch were named to the all-WDA team.

JAMESTOWN: The Blue Jays (2016: 12-3-2 Overall; 8-2-2 WDA) won the consolation championship at the ND State Tournament in Mandan last week. Jamestown rebounded with a 3-0 loss in the quarterfinal to Fargo North, to defeat West Fargo, 1-0 in overtime and St. Mary's, 1-0. The squad was making its first state appearance since 2009.

Against FN, the Blue Jays were on the defensive early and FN would score in the 11th minute and add one later in the half. The Spartans put 20 shots on goal while Jamestown only generate five balls on the net.

Against WF, Jamestown leading scorer Emily Reiten netted the winner in the 82nd minute to advance the team into the fifth place match. Goalkeeper Haley Hillstrom made 11 saves to get the shutout. Against SM, Alex Kudrna snapped a scoreless match with a goal in the 75th minute. The win was Jamestown's third over SM this season. The squad's 2-1 record was matched in 2009 when it also won two en route to a third place finish.

Emily Reiten, Haley Hillstrom, Megan Gaffaney and Cloey Skari were named to the all-WDA team.

LEGACY: The Sabers' (2016: 0-13-2 Overall; 0-11-1 WDA) Mercedes Baumgartner was named to the all-WDA team.

MANDAN: The Braves' (2016: 2-8-4 Overall; 2-7-3 WDA) Sam Bussman was named to the All-WDA team.

MINOT: The Majettes (2016: 12-4-1 Overall; 9-2-1 WDA) finished fourth at the ND State Tournament last week held in Mandan. After getting past Fargo Shanley, 2-1, in the quarterfinal, Minot dropped a one-goal semifinal decision to Fargo Davies, 3-2, and a 3-1 loss to Fargo North.

Against Shanley, Allison Lepp's tally in the 61st minute broke a 1-1 match. Earlier, Kelsi Mensen staked Minot to a 1-0 lead. Against Davies, the Majettes spotted FD a 2-0 lead before its offense generated chances in the second half. Minot eventually, cut the deficit to one on Mensen's goal. After Davies regained its two-goal lead, A. Lepp responded with a goal in the 77th minute. However, that's as close as Minot would get. Goalkeeper Becca Kostenko made 10 saves. Against North, Minot again surrendered two first half goals. Minot's K. Mensen would get one back, but the Spartans would add one in the second half in en route to the win. The Majettes defeated FN earlier this season. For a second time, Minot lost back-to-back matches.

Allison Lepp, Sofia Lewis and Kelsi Mensen were named to the all-tournament team. Mya Lennon, Sofia Lewis, Kelsi Mensen, Alyssa Holtz, Allison Lepp, Beth Pluff, Allison Lepp were named to the all-WDA team.

ST. MARY'S: The Saints (2016: 5-9-3 Overall; 2-6-3 WDA) ended their season with a sixth place showing at the ND State Tournament held in Mandan last week. SM dropped a 1-0 decision to WDA foe Jamestown in the consolation championship. The Saints have qualified for every state tournament since 1996.

Goalkeeper Lindsey Schweitzer was busy, making 18 stops. The Saints lost the quarterfinal to Fargo Davies, 3-0, but rebounded with a 3-2 shootout win over Fargo Shanley in consolation play.

Against Davies, the Saints fell behind early, giving up a goal in the third minute. The Eagles led by two at the half and added a third marker early in the second half.

Against Shanley, Britta Curl's shootout goal was the only one, giving SM the win. Curl netted two other goals. Against Jamestown, SM's offense put nine shots on the Jamestown goal, but couldn't break through. Britta Curl and Lindsey Schweitzer was named to the all-tournament team.

BISMARCK HIGH: The Demons (2016: 4-10-2 Overall; 3-7-2 WDA) ended their season last week, dropping its final two WDA matches. BHS lost 3-0 to Century and then 3-1 to St. Mary's. A win or tie against SM would have secured a state tournament berth. BHS last missed the state tournament in 2009. Against St. Mary's, Madison Burgard staked BHS to a 1-0 lead.

CENTURY: The Patriots (2016: 13-2-0 Overall; 11-1-0 WDA) are the West Region's top seed entering the ND State Tournament this week in Mandan. Century will meet West Fargo, the No. 4 seed from the East Region, in a Thursday, June 2 quarterfinal. Last week, Century's bid for a perfect conference season was foiled by visiting Minot. The Majettes defeated the Pats, 3-0. The loss snapped Century's 23 match unbeaten streak against WDA foes over the past two seasons. Earlier in the week, Century blanked rival BHS, 3-0. Lauren Fleming, Taryn Neameyer and Kylee Welch netted goals. The shutout was Century's 10th.

JAMESTOWN: The Blue Jays (2016: 10-2-2 Overall; 8-2-2 WDA) are the No. 3 seed from the West Region entering this week's ND State Tournament in Mandan. The Blue Jays will take on defending state champion and EDC runner-up Fargo North in a Thursday, June 2 quarterfinal. Jamestown is making its first tournament appearance since 2009. Last week, the squad pick up a pair of shutout wins, defeating Mandan, 2-0, and Legacy, 5-0. Against Mandan, Alex Kudrna and Emily Reiten netted goals. Haley Hillstrom turned away five shots. Against Legacy, E. Reiten recorded a hat trick. She finished the regular season with a team-best 18 goals. Peyton Rudnick and A. Kudrna also scored. Jamestown scored all five goals in the opening half. It finished third in the WDA for the first time since 2007.

LEGACY: The Sabers (2016: 0-13-2 Overall; 0-11-1 WDA) ended their season last week with shutout losses to Minot, 8-0, and Jamestown, 5-0. Legacy was shutout 12 times this season. Goalkeeper Heidi Hilz made nine stops in the match vs. Minot. Against Jamestown, Legacy held the Blue Jays off the scoreboard in the second half.

MANDAN: The Braves' (2016: 2-8-4 Overall; 2-7-3 WDA) season ended with a 2-0 loss at Jamestown last week, ending Mandan's pursuit of a state tournament berth. Goalkeeper Olivia Geiger made eight saves. Mandan was shutout six times this season.

MINOT: The Majettes (2016: 11-2-1 Overall; 9-2-1 WDA) will be the No. 2 seed from the West Region entering this ND State Tournament this week in Mandan. Minot will face Fargo Shanley-Oak Grove, the East Region's third seed, in a Thursday, June 2 quarterfinal. Last week, Minot wrapped up the regular season with shutout wins over Legacy, 8-0; and Century, 3-0. Against Legacy, the Majettes scored four goals in each half. Sofia Lewis netted two goals and assisted on two others. Miya Lennon and Alison Lepp scored a pair of goals. Minot scored three goals in the opening half at Century. S. Lewis, M. Lennon and Kelsi Mensen tallied goals. Goalie Becca Kostenko made six stops for the shutout. Minot is unbeaten in its last six matches. Lennon ended the season with a WDA-best 21 goals.

ST. MARY'S: The Saints (2016: 4-7-3 Overall; 2-6-3 WDA) are the West Region's fourth seed entering this week's ND State Tournament in Mandan. St. Mary's will face EDC champion Fargo Davies in a Thursday, June 2 quarterfinal. SM clinched a state tournament berth for a 21st consecutive season last week with its 3-1 victory over Bismarck High. Britta Curl scored twice and assisted on Kayla VanderVorst's marker.

BISMARCK HIGH: The Demons (2016: 4-8-2 Overall; 3-5-2 WDA) will wrap up regular season play this week, hosting WDA champion Century on Tuesday, May 24 and then the pivotal match vs. St. Mary's, May 26. BHS is still in a position to clinch a state tournament berth. The Demons currently hold a two-point lead over St. Mary's and Mandan in the standings and will clinch that berth with at least two points in its final two matches. If it ends up with one or no points, it falls to fifth or sixth. Last week, BHS dropped two road matches, losing 5-0 to BHS and 6-1 to Jamestown. Payton Dempsey scored the Demons' goal vs. Jamestown.

CENTURY: The Patriots (2016: 12-1-0 Overall; 10-0-0 WDA) will close out WDA play this week, facing rival Bismarck High on Tuesday May 24 and then taking on Minot on May 26. Century is already locked up the No. 1 seed from the West Region for the state tournament which is next week in Mandan. Last week, Century defeated Mandan, 5-0, and Legacy, 7-0. The squad has shutout its last four opponents. Against Mandan, Century's Calista Moch netted two goals.

JAMESTOWN: The Blue Jays (2016: 8-2-2 Overall; 6-2-2 WDA) have already secured a state tournament berth, but finish as high as second with a win and some help this week. The squad will finish no worse than third. That last time the team placed that high was 2007.

Jamestown hosts Mandan on Tuesday, May 24 and then Legacy on May 26. A pair of wins coupled with Minot gaining no more than four points would give the Blue Jays the West Region's second seed. In the event of a tie with Minot, it holds the tie-break with the Majettes based on a 1-0-1 record. Last week, Jamestown defeated Bismarck High, 6-1. Jamestown's leading scorer Emily Reiten netted a pair of goals and assisted on another; Peyton Rudnick scored twice and added an assist.

LEGACY: The Sabers (2016: 0-11-2 Overall; 0-9-1 WDA) will finish its season with a pair of matches this week against Minot at home on Tuesday, May 24 and at Jamestown on May 26. Last week, Legacy snapped its goal scoring drought when it netted a goal in its 3-1 loss to St. Mary's. In fact, the Sabers scored first for the first time this season. Mercedes Baumgartner netted the goal. Legacy then lost to WDA champion Century, 7-0.

MANDAN: The Braves (2016: 2-7-4 Overall; 2-6-3 WDA) are still in contention for a state tournament berth with just one regular season match remaining. Mandan travels to Jamestown on Tuesday, May 24. First things first, the Braves need a win. And then hope BHS gets no more than one point in its final two matches. Mandan holds the tie-break over BHS (goal differential in the two matches). Also, the Braves need St. Mary's to lose or tie its final match vs. BHS. If Mandan and St. Mary's tie with 12 points, the Saints hold tie-break (goal differential among all WDA matches). Last week, Mandan dropped a 5-0 decision to Century and then played to a 1-1 draw with St. Mary's. Sam Bussman netted the Braves' goal.

MINOT: The Majettes (2016: 9-2-1 Overall; 7-2-1 WDA) have already clinched a state tournament berth, but can lock up the second seed from the West Region with a pair of wins. Minot visits Legacy on Tuesday, May 24 and then has a showdown at WDA champion Century on May 26. Minot currently is two points ahead of Jamestown for second place. However, the Blue Jays hold the tie-break based on a 1-0-1 record over Minot. Last week, the Majettes defeated Bismarck High, 5-0. Miya Lennon netted four goals. She leads the conference in scoring. Sofia Lewis had three assists.

ST. MARY'S: The Saints (2016: 3-7-3 Overall; 2-6-3 WDA) are still in contention for a state tournament berth, but will need a win this week over Bismarck High and some help. The Saints are two points behind the Demons for fourth place. A victory over BHS coupled with a BHS loss or tie, vs. Century would give SM the fourth spot. St. Mary's would then hold a 1-0-1 record against BHS. Last week, St. Mary's defeated Legacy, 3-1, and tied Mandan, 1-1. Against Legacy, Marriann Senftner scored twice and assisted on another.
