Treasurer's Report

Ditches and Drainage Work

KY Wired Fiber

Mayor Mason spoke briefly with Morehead Mayor Laura Brown about KY Wired and she would like to learn more about the project at hand. There was discussion about the fiber being strung along US 60 and its path through Lakeview. It is possible that Lakeview could be a "pilot" City for this internet endeavor.

Dumpster

A spring dumpster was discussed with a decision made to continue with only a fall clean-up dumpster

Budget

Land and Water Conservation Fund

Mayor Mason spoke about certain fund matching projects that could be available to the City.
