

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOP STREETS WITHIN THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA AND MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE ANY VEHICLE ON THE STREETS OF THE TOWN IN VIOLATION OF THE POSTED STOP SIGNS, AND ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana:

Section 1 Definitions. The following definitions shall apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this ordinance:

A. "Vehicle": Every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a street including but not limited to automobiles, bicycles, horses and motorcycles.

B. "Emergency vehicle": shall mean and be construed to include police vehicles, vehicles of fire departments, ambulances, or public service corporation vehicles, which are carrying a public official or employee in response to an emergency call or in the immediate pursuit of an actual or suspected violator of the law.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate or cause to be driven or operated any vehicle on a street within the corporate limits of the Town of Cloverdale not under the jurisdiction of the State of Indiana, in such a way as to fail to come to a full and complete stop in front of a posted stop sign.

The Superintendent of Streets shall have the authority to post appropriate signs showing such stop streets and shall have the responsibility of removing old signs in conflict with this ordinance # 1974-16.

Section 3. Exclusion. Emergency vehicles owned by a department of any town, municipality, county, the State of Indiana, the federal government or a public service corporation and operated by its officers or employees upon the streets of Cloverdale while in the course of responding to an emergency call or in the immediate pursuit

of an actual or suspected violator of the law are hereby excluded from the provisions of this ordinance. At all other times drivers of authorized emergency vehicles shall drive in obedience to posted stop signs.

Section 4. Penalty. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in an amount not less than \$5.00 nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each violation.

Section 5. Repealer. This ordinance repeals all prior ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the passage hereof and after due publication as required by law.
