Jumper Division Class Specifications

Puddle Jumper

Open to all riders and horse or ponies. Fence Height: 2'

Novice Children's/Adult Jumper VHSA Associate

Open to children and adult amateurs in their first or second year of showing in the jumpers at 2'6" or higher as of December first, of the current year. Riders may only cross enter into Novice Children's/Adult Jumpers, if eligible, and Low Jumpers. Fence Height 2'3"-'6" with spreads no less than 2'3" and no greater than 2'6"

Novice Jumper VHSA Associate

Open to horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December first, of the current year. Horses or ponies may only cross enter Novice/Children's/Adult Jumpers, if eligible, and Low Jumpers. Fence Height: 2'3"-2'6", with spreads no less than 2'3" and no greater than 2'6"

VHSA Thoroughbred Jumper

Limited to horses that are registered with the Jockey Club. Fence Height: minimum 2'6", maximum 3'0" with spreads no greater than height of fence. May not be combined with any other VHSA Associate recognized division with the exception of the Low Jumper Division

Low Jumper VHSA associate

Open to horses and ponies no restrictions on riders (Exceptions: See Novice Jumper and Novice Child/Adult Jumper.) Fence Height: 2'9' with spreads no less than 2'6" and no greater than fence height.

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers VHSA Associate

Open to horses or ponies ridden by junior & adult amateur riders. No cross entering with the Novice Child/Adult Jumper Fence Height: 3'0" with spreads no less than 2'6" and no greater than the height of the fence.

Schooling Jumper VHSA Associate

Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fence Height 3'3"-3'6" with spreads no less than 3' and no greater than the height of the fence.

Modified Jumper VHSA Associate

Open to horse and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fence Height 3'6"-4' with spreads no less than 3'6" (except in combinations where they must be 3'), and no greater than the height of the fence.

Table II, Sec. 1 (Time First Round)

The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed if any. Horses with clean rounds or equal faults will be classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

Table II, Sec. 2 (b) (Time First Jump Off)

The first round and jump off if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed if any. If the competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring upon audible signal commence the designated Jump Off within 45 sec.

Table II, Sec. 2 (c) (Power & Speed)

The first round and jump off if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed if any. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, they will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the designated jump off course. Time starts as the horse crosses the finish line for the initial course.

Sandstone Farm VHSA Associate Jumper Show begins at 8:30 Am

- 1) A negative Coggins is required.
- **2)** Hard hats are required while mounted.
- **3)** The large ring will be open for schooling at 7:30 AM. The small ring will be available for schooling all day.
- **4)** VHSA Rules Apply.
- **5)** VHSA points will be awarded to current members only.
- **6)** Exhibitors are not required to be a VHSA member to show.
- 7) The show manager reserves the right to combine or cancel classes if there are insufficient entries.
- 8) Returned checks will be assessed a \$25 charge.
- **9)** Ribbon well be awarded to 6th place
- **10)** Class entry fees are \$20 per class.
- 11) There is a grounds/office fee of \$20 per horse. A \$10 credit is offered for entries made online at Sandstonefarm.com.
- **12)** A minimum of 6 entries is required in order to run the **Add Back** classes.
- **13)** An unjudged warm-up round is allowed at any time. Competitors must jump the warm-up course provided. Before entering the ring the rider must inform the gate keeper that the trip is an unjudged warm-up. The fee for warm-up rounds is \$20.
- **14)** Juniors and adults may ride ponies.
- **15)** Both Novice Divisions will run concurrently.
- **16)** High point T.I.P award for OTTB accumulating most points for each division.
- **17)** Sandstone Series points are scored 10,6,4,2,1,.5 for places 1-6. Sandstone Farm reports *placings* to the VHSA to calculate points for VHSA Associate awards using their system which includes bonus points. This can occasionally cause a difference in the Champion and Reserve.
- 18) Year End Awards:
 - Trainer awards: 1st \$500 2nd \$250 3rd \$125
 - Cooler Awards to high point junior and to high point adult amateur riders.
 - Circuit Division awards to high point horse in each division.
- Trainers and riders/owners or a representative must be present at the yearend show to receive an award.
