Global Industrial Company Donates Toys for Autism Awareness Month!

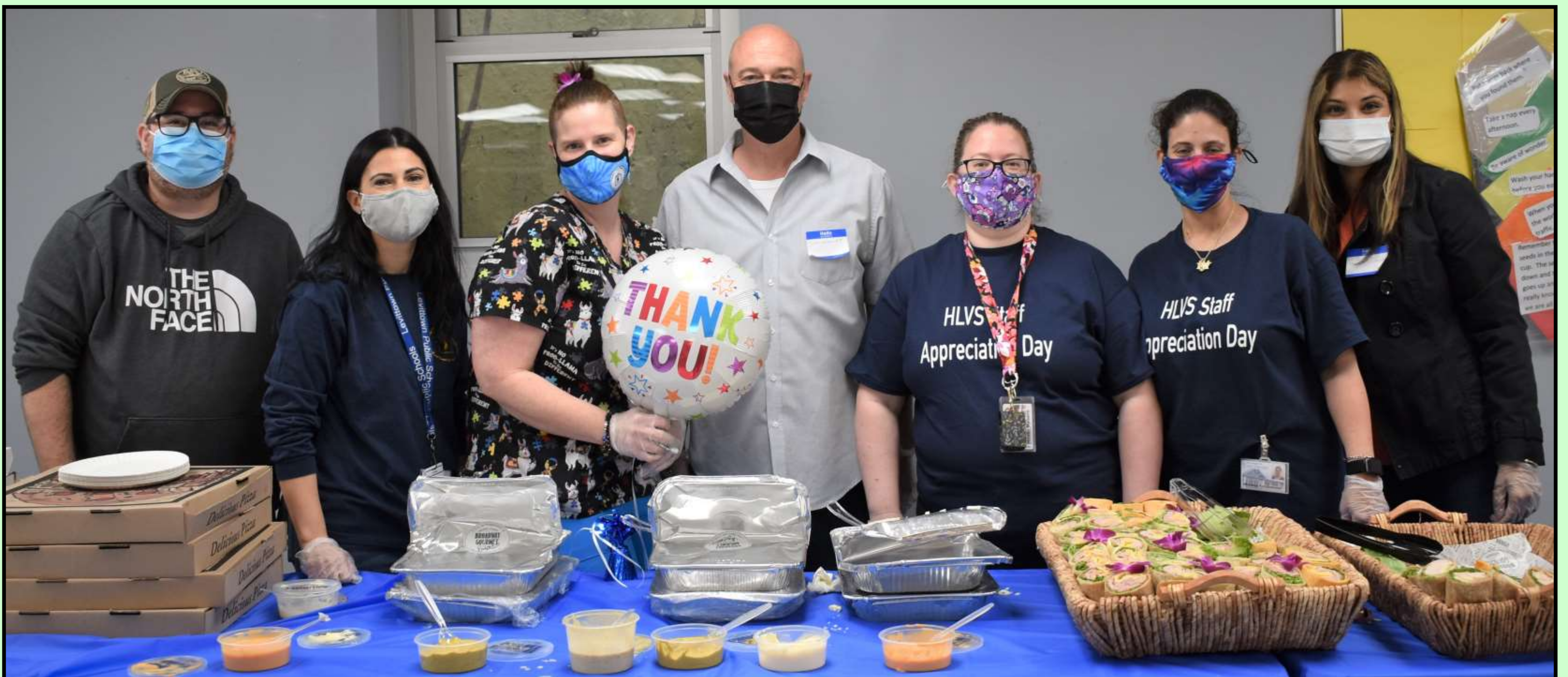

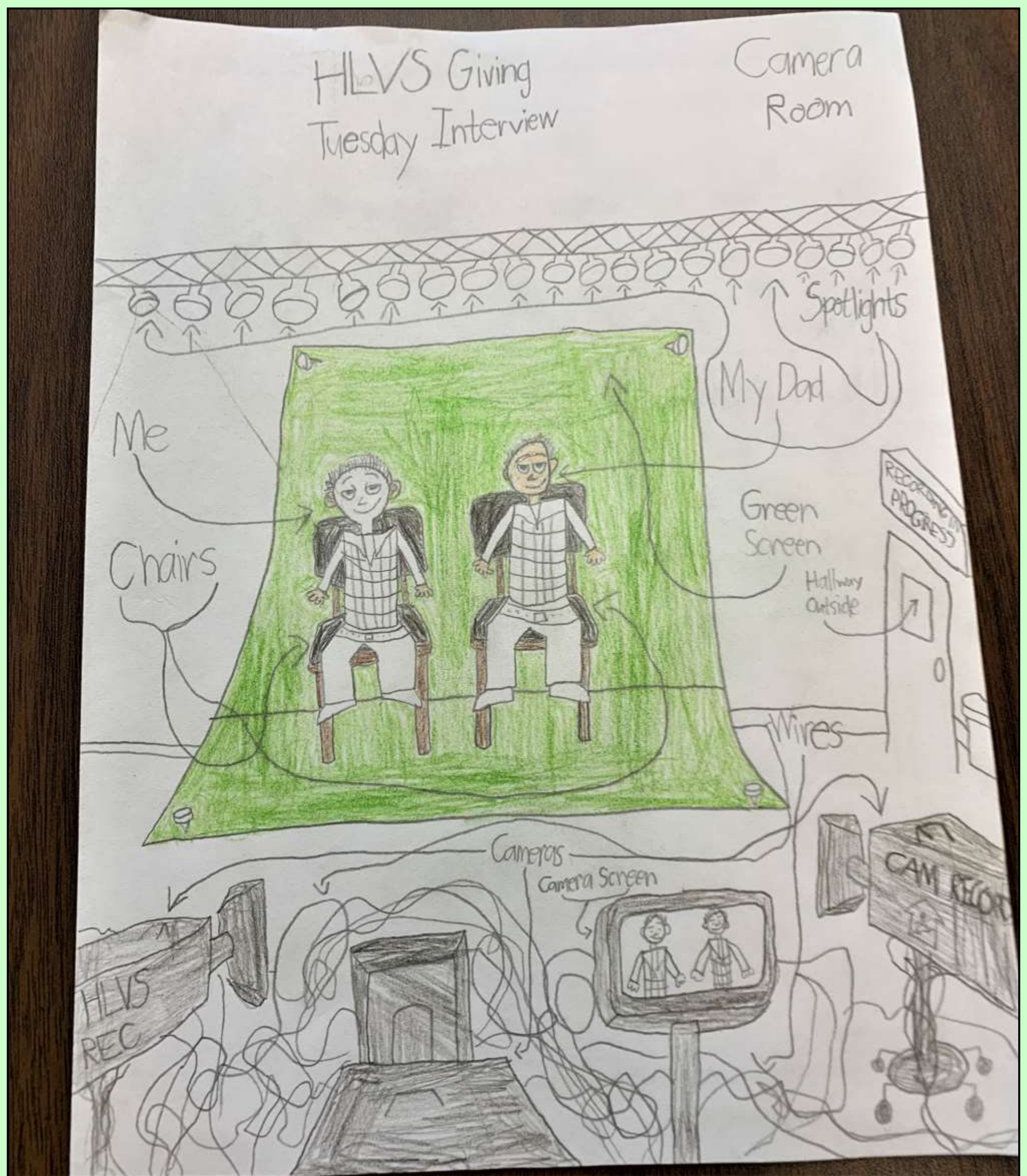
Rodrigo Ramos Esquivel

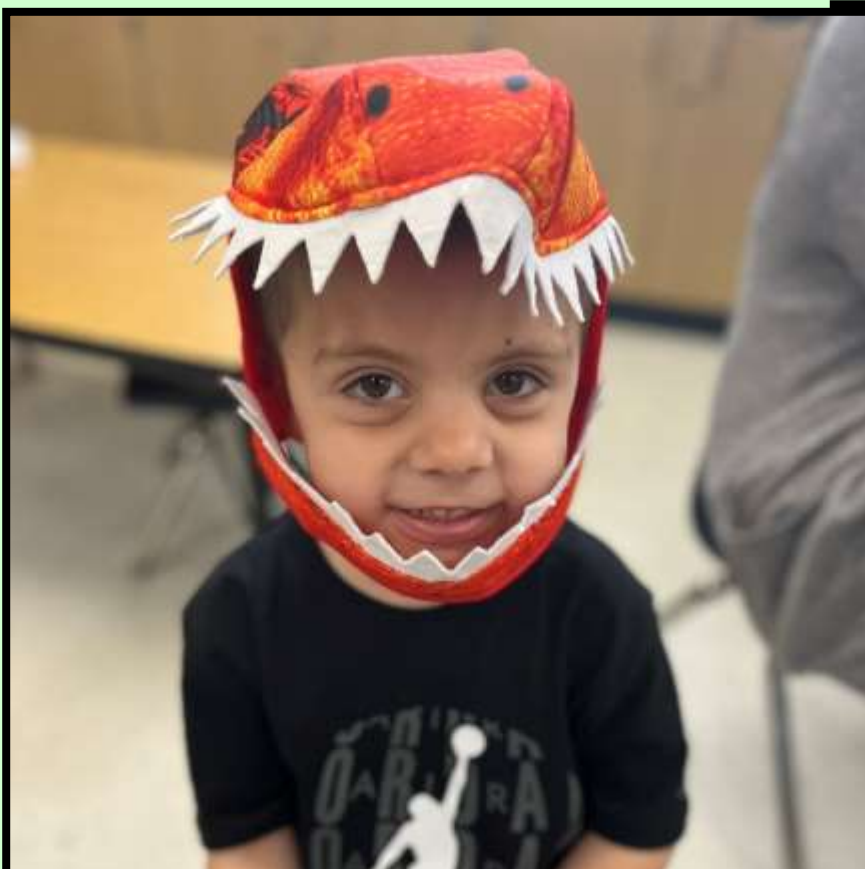

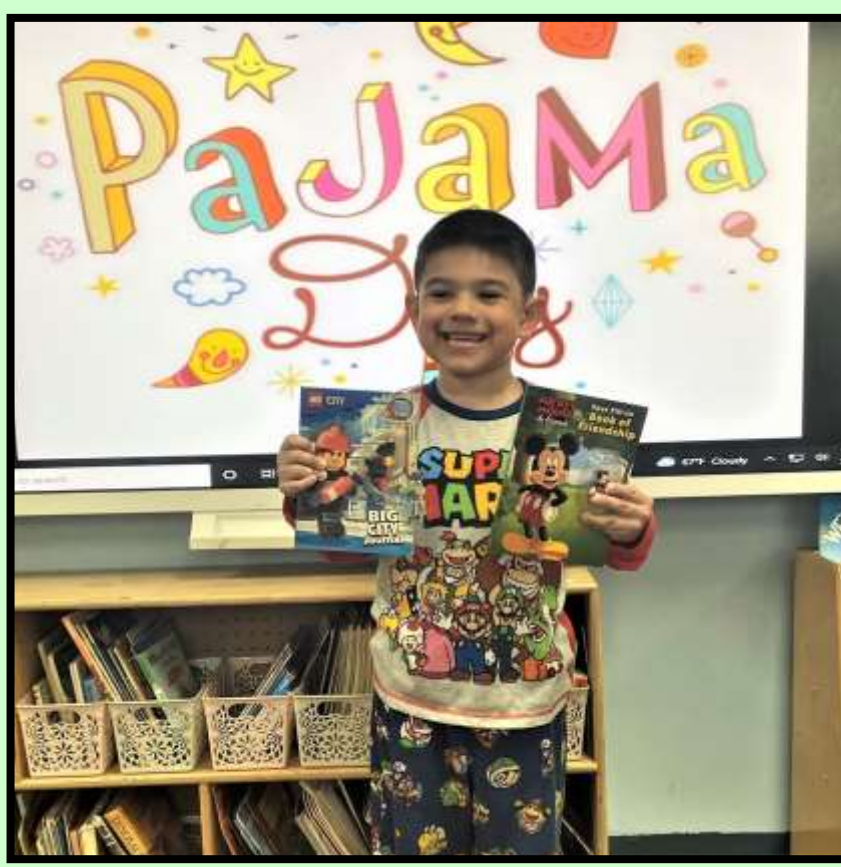
