The Harmony House is proud to present the **2020-21** annual student events, providing inspiration, accountability, and musical growth for the budding musician.

- **“Sundaes on Saturday” (Sat, August 1, 2020, 12 - 2 p.m.):** Our **Back-to-School celebration** features **FREE** ice cream sundaes, live music provided by our students and instructors, music-related games & activities, door prizes, and a “test an instrument” booth. Great for the rising 6th grade band/orchestra student and other music students. Bring a friend and enjoy this **FREE** family-friendly event.
- **New Song Fellowship, Sundays, 10 a.m.,** 2933 Cherokee St., Kennesaw 30144. Music and drama rehearsal – preparing for the upcoming service, Wed at 6:30, 4496 Carnes St., Acworth 30101. Encourage your student to use his or her talent in a worship context for the glory of the Lord. 2nd Sundays of the month we offer a worship service at 9:30, Must Ministries, 55 Elizabeth Dr., Marietta. Join us!
- **Christmas and Spring Recitals:** Recitals are held on Friday at 6 and Saturdays at 10:30, 1:30, or 3 p.m. in December and May: 12/4, 12/5, 12/11, 12/12, 12/18, 12/19 and 5/1, 5/7, 5/8, 5/14, 5/15, 5/21, 5/22 by instructor appointment. Students learn two selections and perform in front of a small audience. Recitals are held in the Great Room at 2933 Cherokee St., Kennesaw 30144 or 4496 Carnes St., Acworth 30101. Some recitals are held in local church venues. There is a \$27 participation fee per family payable by Fri, Nov 21 and Apr 24, covering recital costs. Guests are welcome.
- **Festival (Sat, Feb. 6, 2021, by appointment, 4496 Carnes St, Acworth).** Students memorize two selections and play in front of an adjudicator with the potential to earn up to 5 points annually. At 15, 30, 45 and 60 points the student earns a gold cup and plays in the gold cup recital (see below). There is a \$37/student fee for this event.
- **Conservatory/Gold Cup Recital (Sat, Mar 13, 2019, 1 p.m., Great Room, 2933 Cherokee St.):** Students are selected for the Conservatory by instructor recommendation and achieve the musical goals as stated in the conservatory handbook, playing once annually in the conservatory recital. This event also showcases our Festival gold cup recipients (see above) and High School Seniors. **FREE** to all students and attendees.
- **“Scale-a-Thon” (Sat, March 27, 2021, 1 p.m., Great Room, 2933 Cherokee St):** Celebrating the mastery of the building blocks of music – scales, chords, and arpeggios with musical games, ribbons & trophies, and refreshments. (Due date for Mastery Sheet & fee: Sat, Mar 20 by Noon.) There is a \$27 participation fee per family for this event.
- **Big Shanty:** This **FREE** event is held in our tent in downtown Kennesaw, traditionally the second or third Saturday and Sunday in April, TBD. Students may sign up to play a five minute music set in our tent or (by audition) be a part of a band on the plaza stage, providing fun and festivity to the Big Shanty Festival.
