The burn ban has been lifted. Per the Fire Chief, recreational fires are allowed again. However, burning of yard waste or garbage is never allowed.

Per the Rockford Snow Plow Policy...

The Public Works operator will decide when to begin snow or ice control operations. The criteria for that decision will be:

Snow accumulation of four inches or more with the exception of East Emma Street which will be plowed at about two inches of snowfall.

Time of snowfall in relationship to heavy use of streets
