AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CISCO, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 13 “MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” OF THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 13-52 “SPECIFIC ZONES ESTABLISHED” TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL PARKING CONTROL ZONE FOR THE COMMERCIAL BUSINESS DISTRICT; ADDING SECTION 13.53 “PARKING TIME LIMITS ESTABLISHED”; AND ADDING SECTION 13-57 “VIOLATIONS; PENALTY”; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF ENFORCEMENT.
