Seeding Rates:


15-25 pounds per acre in a straight stand. In mixtures, this amount can be reduced to 50% or less of the total mixture. A seeding depth of 1/4"-1/2" is best for establishment.

Harvestar Orchardgrass has been trialed extensively and has proven reliable in yield, digestibility and persistence. **Harvestar** is an improved, late maturing variety selected for increased yields and improved cold tolerance. Its broader spreading and more aggressive crown habit gives **Harvestar** the ability to handle close grazing.

Harvestar performs well in a mono-stand or in mixtures with other grasses and/or legumes. It's maturity range is very suitable with alfalfa. It is ideal for hay production, grazing, silage and green chop. **Harvestar** has greater heat, drought & shade tolerance than timothy, bluegrass and ryegrass.

Management Tips:

Mechanically harvest it or graze it early in order to promote high yields of superior forage quality. Do not over graze. Orchardgrass Ideal for the Upper-Midwest, Midwest, Northeast, Transition zone and Coastal regions of US and Canada.
