

# TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

## August 21, 2017

The Town Council met August 21, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Thorsby Municipal Annex Building.

Mayor Hight called the meeting to order at 6:00p.m. Chief Barnett gave the invocation.

Council Member Littleton moved to approve the minutes from August 7, 2017 as presented. Council Member Crumpton seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Collins, Chapman, Benson and Crumpton.

New Business

Mayor Hight stated he needed a motion to pass a Resolution for the Alabama Community Development Block Grant.

Council Member Benson moved to approve the Resolution for the Alabama Community Development Block Grant. Council Member Chapman seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Collins, Chapman, Benson and Crumpton.

Mayor Hight recognized Van Forrester with the Chilton County IDB.

Van Forrester with the Chilton County IDB explained to the Council that the IDB wanted to hire a full time person for Chilton County and they are asking for each Municipality to pay a portion of the salary and it would be based on the Municipalities population. Thorsby part would be \$5837.11. Once it's passed it would be an ongoing thing.

Council Member Littleton moved to approve the Chilton County IDB salary for \$5837.11. Council Member Benson seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Collins, Chapman, Benson and Crumpton.

## Report from Department Heads

Rodney Barnett gave the Council a copy of his activity report for July.

Mayor Hight reported about Alabama Ave. and Franklin St. intersection. He stated someone is going to get killed at this intersection if we don't do something. He stated they need to get some type of rumble sticks for this intersection.

Mayor Hight stated they would get some prices and bring it back to the next Council meeting.

Zac Hamm with the Fire Department reported they had a guy Coby Ramsey that had completed the 30 day ride along and wanted to hire him as a part time shift fireman and call out. Zac stated he would start out at a step 2 at \$12.88.

Council Member Littleton moved to hire Coby Ramsey as a part time shift fireman and call out. Council Member Benson seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Collins, Chapman, Benson and Crumpton.

Mayor Hight stated Terry Jackson had a meeting with Collin Chapel Fire department and would not be present.

Town Clerk Crystal Smith reminded the Council the next Council meeting need to be changed from September 4<sup>th</sup> to the 5<sup>th</sup> due to a Holiday on the 4<sup>th</sup>.

Council Member Collins moved to approve the Council Meeting for September 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 P.M. Council Member Chapman seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Collins, Chapman, Benson and Crumpton.

Town Clerk Crystal Smith reminded the Council after the meeting on Sept 5<sup>th</sup> there would be a work session on the budget.

Town Clerk Crystal Smith reminded the Council of the FFA Banquet at Jeff State on August 24 at 6:30pm and it would be \$20 a plate.

Mayor Hight reported that the engineers with the paving company for Jones St. stated the paving was fine and everything would stay the same.

Council Member Chapman moved to approve the bills, transfer funds. Council Member Collins seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Benson, Chapman, Collins, and Crumpton.
