## Key Plants That Support Our Native Bees

Plants that support native bees include milkweeds (*Asclepias*), goldenrods (*Solidago*), asters (*Symphyotrichum*), willows (*Salix*), and summersweet (*Clethra alnifolia*). Additional plants that support bees include:

Beardtongue (*Penstemon digitalis*)  
Bee Balm, Wild Bergamot (*Monarda fistulosa*)  
Blazing Star, Gayfeather (*Liatris spicata*)  
Blue Sundial Lupine (*Lupinus perennis*)  
Blue Vervain (*Verbena hastata*)  
Dotted Mint (*Monarda punctata*)  
Joe Pye Weed (*Eutrochium fistulosum*)  
Lance-leaved Tickseed (*Coreopsis lanceolata*)  
Mountain Mint (*Pycnanthemum muticum*)  
Partridge Pea (*Chamaecrista fasciculata*)  
Purple Coneflower (*Echinacea purpurea*)
