<u>PLACE</u>: The meeting was held at the Authority's Administration building located at 199 Foul Rift Road, Belvidere, New Jersey.

<u>PURPOSE</u>: For the purpose of prescribing a schedule of service charges for sewer treatment to the Town of Belvidere, Township of White, Township of Oxford, County of Warren, and all other users of the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority.

Chairwoman Napolitani read the Introductory Statement. This annual budget and rate hearing has been properly noticed in accordance with New Jersey State Statutes.

Mr. Francisco stated that the appropriations for the 2025 budget have increased by \$125,873.00 from 2024. The total budget will be \$2,713,323.00. The increase is due to inflation affecting several items in the budget. Debt Service accounts for 27% of the budget, which is \$729,601.00.

To fund the 2025 budget, we will collect 5% more from our customers as we did in 2024 - \$2,643,323.00. The remaining balance of our revenue will come from interest income of approximately \$60,000.00; miscellaneous income of \$10,000.00. This is the second year we will not be using any funds from our Rate Stabilization Fund to fund our operating budget. The operating budget will be fully funded by service fees and other miscellaneous revenues.

The 2025 capital expenses are estimated at \$2,332,000.00, this includes a major improvement to the sludge thickener at the Belvidere plant. This will cost approximately \$2.1 million. We will finance this project through the NJ State I-Bank.

Other small capital projects will be funded using the Unrestricted Net Position funds (surplus). These projects should total approximately \$232,000.00.

We have fourteen (14) users in our system. Meter readings are conducted monthly, and the meters are calibrated quarterly. Our billing cycle is from October 1st through September 30th. Billing is based on the average flow from the prior three years. For 2025, an I&I factor of 11% is applied. Each user's percent of the total water used is applied against the budget to determine their amount. He explained the process used to determine the rates in more detail. The residential user rate for 2025 will be \$12.50 per billing unit. The industrial user rate for 2025 is \$25.00 per billing unit. A billing unit is 1,000 gallons.

Our Connection Fee for 2025 will increase to \$7,000.00 from \$6,642.00, which we have held that amount for many years. We are raising to \$7,000.00 to help with inflation and our increased capital costs. Based on actual calculations, we could charge as much as \$12,264.00 based on the State formula.

Mr. Francisco asked if there were any questions or comments from Board members

There was no public present.

Chairwoman Napolitani asked for a motion to approve the FY2025 budget.

Ms. Skoog moved to adopt Resolution #24-34 to approve the FY2025 Rules & Regulations. Mr. Norton seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Mr. Roth moved to adopt Resolution #24-35 to approve the FY2025 Connection Fees. Ms. Skoog seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Ms. Skoog moved to adopt Resolution #24-36 to approve the FY2025 Operating and Capital Budgets, and Mr. Accetturo seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

As there was no further discussion, Mr. Norton moved, and Mr. Roth seconded that the Public Rate Hearing be adjourned at 7:06 p.m. All in favor, motion carried.

RESOLUTION NO: 24-34

AMENDING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE WARREN COUNTY (PEQUEST RIVER) MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY TO INCORPORATE ANNUAL ADJUSTMENTS TO THE AUTHORITY'S FEE AND CHARGES FOR SEWER CONNECTIONS AND FOR SEWER TREATMENT SERVICES AND TO PROVIDE OTHER RATE AND FEE CHANGES.

WHEREAS, the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority (the Authority) has adopted rules and regulations entitled Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority - Service Rules (Rules and Regulations) pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has the right and obligation to change or amend, from time to time, its Rules and Regulations in order that they should continue to reflect the current operating requirements of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, public notice of the Authority's annual rate hearing as required pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:14B-23 was timely provided; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2024, the Authority conducted a public hearing on its rates and fees and is of the opinion that the proposed revision to the connection fees and user rates should be adopted, and that the Rules and Regulations should be amended to reflect the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Warren County (Pequest River)
Municipal Utilities Authority, in the County of Warren, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. A new Appendix C to the Authority's Rules and Regulations shall be included therein as follows:

APPENDIX C

WARREN COUNTY (PEQUEST RIVER) MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY SCHEDULE OF SEWAGE TREATMENT SERVICE CHARGES AND CONNECTION FEES:

1. General:

The Authority hereby sets forth the current applicable sewage treatment charges and connection fees as adopted by the Authority in accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22 and 23.

A) An additional 11% Inflow & Infiltration (I&I) factor shall be assessed on all users billed on a metered flow basis (either water use or sewer discharge), with the exception of Belvidere and Oxford whose metered flow includes system-wide I&I, in order to establish equitable allocation of system-wide I&I.

B) Sewage Treatment Services FY2025

Class of User Rates

-Residential \$12.50 per billing unit -Industrial \$25.00 per 1,000 gallons

C) Connection Fees FY2025*

The FY 2025 connection fee shall increase to \$7,000.00. The amount of \$7,000.00 per EDU (equivalent dwelling unit) is less than the calculated amount of \$12,264.00.

- * Affordable housing projects built by Public Housing Authorities and non-profit organizations will receive a reduction of 50% in connection fees, pursuant to C40:14B-22.
- 2. The foregoing amendment to the Rules and Regulations shall take effect as of December 17, 2024, the date of its adoption by a majority of the Members of the Authority, and this Resolution shall be conclusive evidence of the fact that the amendment was approved by a majority of the Members of the Authority at that time.

3. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Rules and Regulations of the Authority shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
